### Day 01 . Valencia- Gruta De San Jose- Vilafames- Peñíscola.-

#### Welcome to your Europamundo Trip Style!!

The information about the meeting place and start time of your circuit can be found on your voucher.

Throughout our trip we will have the opportunity to get to know various towns belonging to the association of "The Most Beautiful Towns In Spain".

We leave Valencia heading north, crossing the fertile orchard and orange groves until we reach the province of Castellón, where we find the **CAVE OF SAN JOSÉ**. It's the longest navigable underground river in Europe, with fabulous stalactites and stalagmites. We will take a nice boat ride on its calm waters (entrance included).

We continue towards **VILAFAMES**. Located in a beautiful enclave, also included in the list of the "most beautiful towns in Spain". Locality chosen by many artists as a place of residence, located on a mountain overlooking a beautiful valley with centuries-old olive fields. In the highest part, the remains of its medieval castle still remain. Houses built with sandstone, reddish colour (rodено), typical of the area. Walk with our tour guide through its quiet streets. We will have time to have lunch and savour its rich gastronomy where the "olleta" of Vilafamés stands out.

We continue to the north of the province of Castellón to visit the beautiful town of **PENISCOLA**. Considered one of "The most beautiful towns in Spain". The old town is located on a rocky promontory within the sea surrounded by strong walls.

At its top is the Templar Castle that was residence in the 15th century of Benedict the XIII, also called the moon pope, very well preserved. Arrival at the hotel. Accommodation in Peñíscola or surroundings.

### Day 02 . Peñíscola- Morella- Cantavieja- Teruel.-

We leave the Azahar Coast head towards the Maéstrate mountains where **MORELLA** is located, another of the most beautiful villages once again. Medieval walled town on a mountain with a great panoramic view of the surroundings. Time to stroll through its network of medieval streets with churches, palaces, shops and restaurants where we will be able to taste its excellent gastronomy with rich cold meats, cheeses and typical sweets such as its curd and "flaons".

We leave the Valencian Community to cross "Bajo Aragón". Our first stop will be in **CANTAVIEJA**, small defensive village in what is called the emptied Spain. Time to stroll and contemplate its beautiful Main Square arcades.

We continue to **TERUEL**, considered the capital of Mudejar Art and declared UNESCO world heritage city. Accompanied by our guide we will be able to see the impressive Mude-

jar bell towers built in brick with mainly green and white ceramic geometric decorations. We can enjoy its good gastronomy, known for the Serrano ham from Teruel or its roasted lamb. Accommodation.

### Day 03 . Teruel- Albarracín- Enchanted City- Cuenca.-

Following the journey through the most beautiful villages in Spain we arrive at **ALBARRACÍN**. We will walk with our guide among its tortuous cobbled streets of medieval origin.

We are heading to Castilla la Mancha through different mountain ranges of the Iberian System. Along the way we will be accompanied by beautiful landscapes full of forests, mountains and their valleys. We arrive at the mountains area of Cuenca where we will stop to visit **ENCHANTED CITY**, a spectacular natural spot, with very curious rock formations within the dense forest (entrance included).

Once in the lowest part of the city we will enjoy of a walking guided tour by the historic centre, town hall, Saint Nichols cocathedral, Saint Mary basilique, the esplanada, a beautiful promenade along the sportive port. Time for dinner and accommodation.

### 05 . Alicante- Castell de Guadalest- Costa Blanca- Albufera- Valencia.-

We leave the city of Alicante heading North. Not far away from the coast, in the mountains, we reach the small Town of **CASTELL DE GUADALEST**, declared a Historic Artistic Complex in 1974 and also belonging to our list of "Most Beautiful Villages in Spain.



# GALICIA AND NORTHERN PORTUGAL

**Day 01 . Santiago De Compostela- Castro Borneiro- Camelle- Camariñas- English Cemetery- Mugia- Fisterra.-**

**Welcome to your Europamundo Trip Style!!!**

The information about the meeting place and start time of your circuit can be found on your voucher.

We leave Santiago towards **A CORUÑA**, where we will visit its port, with its famous roman lighthouse still in operation, the so-called Tower of Hercules, the Paseo do Orzán (Orzán Seafront) or the old town with María Pita Square, remembering an ancient heroin.

We continue to two archaeological sites, **CASTRO BORNEIRO** (Borneiro Celtic settlement) and **DOMBATE DOLMEN** (important Celtic and Neolithic culture examples).

Afterwards, stop at **CAMELLE** in order to know Manfred Gnadinger's house-museum, famous and peculiar German hermit artist who lived in this area.

We head to **CAMARIÑAS**, a world-famous fishing village for its famous palilleiras and their bobbin laces; time to stroll through its port and visit Cape Vilán, where we find its emblematic lighthouse in a paradisiacal environment.

After lunch we will visit the **English Cemetery** area, one of the most fateful places in the Death Coast (Costa da Morte) due to its numerous shipwrecks.

We continue to **MUXIA**, located in an impressive landscape, with its Our Lady of the Boat Sanctuary (Santuário da Virxe da Barca), and its legendary environment that our guide will explain to us.



EZARO

Later we will arrive at a magical site: **FINISTERRE**, the “Finis Terrae” for the Romans, where the world ended. We’ll walk to its lighthouse on Finisterre Cape. You can climb to the top of Facho Hill (Monte do Facho), with incredible views of rugged landscapes and stunning beaches.

We return to the village where we will have time for walk or taste the local seafood. **Accommodation.**

### Day 02 . Finisterre - Ézaro Falls - Corrubedo Dunes - Pazo Baion Winery -Cambados - Arousa Island - Pontevedra.-

We leave Finisterre and after a few kilometers we are in front of the **EZARO FALLS**, the only one in Europe of a river that flows into the sea.

We continue our journey through the **Outes Mountains** until we reach **CORRUBEDO DUNES Natural Park**, large mobile dune by the sea in a protected natural area; if you wish, we can go for a 30-minute walk.

At the end of the morning, we will have a wine experience, **visiting a wine cellar and tasting the local Albariño wine, D.O Rías Baixas, at Bodegas Conde de Albarei** in PAZO BAION (Baion Palace).

We arrive in **CAMBADOS**, capital of the wine we have just tasted. We can have lunch in one of the taverns in the old town, monumental historical-artistic complex, and visit the beautiful gothic-style Santa Mariña Dozo Church ruins.

Later we will head to the **AROUSA ISLAND**, crossing by an almost two km long bridge. From the viewpoint called O Con do Forno, the highest point in the Illa where the Punta Cabalo Lighthouse is located, we will discover one of the most beautiful sunsets in the estuary.

We finish the day arriving at **PONTEVEDRA**. Time for dinner and accommodation.

### Day 03 . Pontevedra- O Grove- Isla de A Toxa- Combarro - Pontevedra.-

Breakfast and departure to **O GROVE**, where we will take a **boat ride between “bateas” (mussels farms) with mussels and albariño wine tasting.**

After this experience, we will pass through a century-old bridge to the **A TOXA ISLAND** with its famous Spa, Grand Hotel or the Shells Chapel, completely covered with scallop shells.

Then we will visit **COMBARRO**, a fishermen and shellfish gatherers village, famous for its multiple hórreos (granaries) and cruceiros (stone path crucifixes) in its old area.

After lunch, we return to **PONTEVEDRA**, a friendly city that invites you to get lost in its medieval old town, its boardwalks and the river, an international reference for urban quality and sustainability. Time for dinner and accommodation.



### Day 04 . Pontevedra- Baiona- A Guarda- Valença- Ríver Sil Canyon- Santiago de Compostela.-

We leave Pontevedra and reach **BAIONA**. We will discover its wonderful old quarter and its fish and seafood fish market. La Pinta Caravel arrived here in 1493 with the discovery of America news. We can also visit an exact replica of the Caravel, in which it is represented as daily life was at the great navigation times.

We continue our journey to **A GUARDA**, one of the most important tourist sites in Galicia. We will visit another magical place, the **Castro de Santa Tegra or Santa Tecla** Celtic settlement, belonging to the Castrexa culture (Celtic culture), located on the mountain of the same name and privileged place from which you can see the river Minho mouth.

From A Guarda we will take a **ferry** that will take us to **Caminha, Northern Portugal**, and once there we will head to **VALENÇA**, village-fortress strategically located on the border. Free time to walk and have lunch in its lively streets.

We take our path to reach the Holy Bank area (Ribeira Sacra), land marked by the rivers Minho and Sil that, as it passes between mountains, shape this beautiful landscape.

**Day 01 . Madrid- Lerma- Santo Domingo De La Calzada- Najera- Tricio- Logroño.-**

**Welcome to your Europamundo Trip Style!!!**

The information about the meeting place and start time of your circuit can be found on your voucher.

We will go out of Madrid, north direction and we will stop in the city of **LERMA**, where its imposing Ducal Palace ( nowadays Parador Hotel), dominates the plain of the river Arlanza. Time for a coffee.

We will continue towards La Rioja to discover a population connected to Santiago's road: **SANTO DOMINGO DE LA CALZADA**. This city was found by the homonymous Saint, in order to offer safety and refuge to the pilgrims on the French way. With our guide, we could visit the Cathedral where the Saint's body is preserved and the famous gothic henhouse. ( Entrance not included) Time to have lunch.

We continue crossing the La Rioja with its beautiful landscape to get **NAJERA**, another city where the pilgrims also use to cross. This village is divided by the river Najerilla and in its edge, there is a very important monument: the **Monastery of**



LA GUARDIA. BODEGAS

**Saint Mary Real (Entrance included)** There is one magnificent cloister of the Knights of XVI Century, where there is a combination of Gothic, Plateresque and Renaissance styles. It is time to have a coffee and walk around.

Not so far away from this city, we will stop in **TRICIO** where we find the Basilica of Saint Mary of the Arches, the oldest religious monument of La Rioja. Its origin came from a Christian Basilica of III Century and has changed to a Christian Basilica in V Century, recycling architectural elements from the Roman city of Tritium Megallum- Tricio, the Great, which corresponded to the current village of Tricio, Najera and other small near locations.

We finish our day today in **LOGRONO**. Time to have dinner and Accommodation.

## Day 02 . Ruta del vino: Briones-Haro-Laguardia-El Ciego-Logrono.-

Our first stop in this wine tourist route will be in **BRIONES** where we will have the first contact with the vineyards of La Rioja. This location is situated on the top of a hill where the North slope is separated by the Ebro River. There is a very interesting Medieval urban style in the majority of the constructions which were built with granite stones.

Continuing our wine tourist route, we will visit **HARO, capital of the wine of La Rioja**. Its wineries are very important and international recognized, as well as its artistic and architectural legacy: The City Hall, the Saint Thomas Church, plenty of Palaces and ancestral streets. 

**Day 01 . Bilbao- San Millan De La Cogolla- Santo Domingo De La Calzada- Najera- Tricio- Haro.-**

**Welcome to your Europamundo Trip Style!!!**

We go out of Bilbao towards **SAN MILAN DE LA COGOLLA**, small municipality of La Rioja situated down the Demanda Mountains . Arriving there we will visit the **Monastery of Yuso (Entrance Included)**, declared World Heritage and where approximately one thousand years ago , one Monk wrote few words in the romance language and these ones are considered the first written words in Castilian.

Continuing our route , going to the heart of **La Rioja** to discover a population connected to Santiago's road: **SANTO DOMINGO DE LA CALZADA**. This city was found by the homonymous saint in order to offer safety and refuge to the pilgrims on the French way. With our guide , we could have a walk in the city and in case you wish, you could visit the Cathedral where the saint's body is preserved and the famous gothic henhouse. (Entrance not Included) Time to have lunch.

We continue crossing **La Rioja** with its beautiful landscape to arrive in NAJERA, another place where the pilgrims use to cross. This village is divided by the river Najerilla and in one of its edge, there is a very important monument: **the Monastery of Saint Mary Real (Entrance Included)**. There is a combination of Gothic, Plateresque and Renaissance styles. It is time to have a coffee and walk.

Not so far away from this city, we will stop in **TRICIO** where we find the **Basilica of Saint Mary of the Arches, (Entrance Included)** the oldest religious monument of La Rioja. Its origin came from a Roman mausoleum of III Century and has changed to a Christian Basilica in V Century, recycling architectonic elements from the Roman city of Tritium Megallum-Tricio the Great, which corresponded to the current village of Tricio, Najera and other small near locations.

Our next stop will be in **HARO**, capital of wine of La Rioja region. We will have time to walk around and have dinner in some of those taverns or some restaurants of the city. Accommodation.

## Day 02 . Haro- Briones- San Vicente de Sonsierra- Laguardia- Elciego- Bilbao.-

After the breakfast we will go to discover the city of **HARO** with our guide. Its wineries are very important and internationally recognized, as well as its artistic and architectural legacy: the City Hall, the Saint Thomas Church, plenty of palaces and ancestral streets. In the middle of this morning we will visit **one of their famous wineries (Entrance Included)** to discover the process of its elaboration and, of course, there will be also a tasting of delicious wines.

Next stop will be in **BRIONES**, one of the most beautiful villages of La Rioja. This location is situated on the top of a hill where the north slope is cut by the Ebro river. There is a very interesting medieval urban style in the majority of the constructions which were built with granite stones. Time for lunch.

We will continue our trip towards La Rioja, passing by some small populations with a great Artistic Heritage of Medieval times and connected to Santiago's road such as: **SAN VICENTE DE LA SONSIERRA**. We will stop on the way to appreciate the famous view of its fortress castle and many vineyard fields.

We will discover in our next stop **LAGUARDIA**, beautiful, unique, situated on the top of a hill surrounded by vineyards, with walls and streets full of historic events between the Kingdoms of Navarra and Castilla. Famous because of wines. Time to have a walk and with our guide we will visit the Adega YSIOS, project of Santiago Calatrava. (Entrance not included)

Another essential visit in La Rioja region is **ELCIEGO**. The Palace houses, with a traditional architecture contrast with spectacular hotel projected by the architect Frank Gehry for the Adega Marquês de Riscal

Going back to Bilbao we could continue enjoying the wine tradition of the lands of La Rioja. **Arrival and end of services.** Our guide will drop you off at the agreed point.



BLAYE Y EL RIO GARONA

### Day 01 . Bordeaux- Pauillac- Lamarque- Blaye- Saint Emilion.-

Welcome to your Europamundo Trip Style!!!

The information about the meeting place and start time of your circuit can be found on your voucher.

After breakfast. Our first stop will be at the confluence of the Garonne and Dordogne rivers, and between vineyards we head to **PAUILLAC**, capital of the Médoc wine, time to stroll through its charming marina. We will continue to the **LAMARQUE** pier to cross the Garona river by boat. We will arrive at **BLAYE**, and we will enjoy our free time in this beautiful walled citadel, classified World Heritage by UNESCO. A 17th century military masterpiece, the Blaye Citadel has witnessed many historical and military events due to its strategic location.

We will continue to to **SAINT-EMILION**, declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO and we will visit the Clos des Menuts, where you will discover its beautiful monolithic cellars from the 12th century located in the heart of the medieval city. Accommodation.

## Day 02 . Saint Emilion – Aubeterre-sur-Dronne - Brantome – Perigueux – Les Eyzies de Tayac - Lascaux Caves – Sarlat.-

After Breakfast. We will start our day in the pretty village of **AUBETERRE-SUR-DRONNE**, where we will find an unusual landmark, the monolithic church of Saint-Jean, **the underground church of Saint-Jean**, that was carved in the rock in the 12th century by Benedictine monks. We will visit its interior (**entrance included**)

We will head toward **BRANTOME**, with romantic architecture, called the “green Venice” of Périgord. We will find remarkable places such as the Benedictine abbey, and we will have a walk in the streets of the old town.

Nearby is the city of **PERIGUEUX**, located at the pilgrims’ pass on the Camino de Santiago with an important historical heritage, majestic castles, vestiges of the medieval or Renaissance times, cathedral, abbeys and priories, witnesses of an intense spiritual life. We will see lands with the fields where such noble products as strawberries, truffles and mushrooms are coming from.

Time to walk through the capital of Perigord.

We continue visiting **LES EYZIES-DE-TAVAC-SIREUIL**, known for its high concentration of prehistoric caves to discover. The National Museum of Prehistory is located here. Time for a walk

We continue with rock art making with a visit of one of the most important caves, **Lascaux Caves (entrance included)**

We finish the day in the small medieval town of **SARLAT**, a world heritage site, preserving an incredibly well-preserved Renaissance historic center with its markets essential to taste their gastronomy: foie gras, mushrooms, confit, magret, truffles, nuts wines... Time to enjoy all of them and accommodation.

## Day 03 . Sarlat – Beynac-et-Cazenac - La Roque-Gageac - Domme - Turenne – Collonges la Rouge - Martel – Rocamadour.-

In the morning we will travel along the Dordogne River. Between cliffs, we will visit wonderful villages such as **BEYNAC-ET-CAZENAC**, where the **Castle of Beynac** is located (**entrance included**). Dating from the 12th century and one of the best-preserved medieval castles, it preserves its authenticity and offers amazing views of the valley and river.

Following the river path we will stop at **LA ROQUE-GAGEAC**, located down of a cliff where we will discover its narrow streets, its troglodytic fort, its tropical vegetation and its small church that dominates the valley.



A few kilometers from there we will meet **DOMME**, where we will make a brief stop to be able to contemplate from its viewpoint an exceptional panoramic view of the Dordogne valley.

We follow the river on our way to **TURENNE**, a small town that preserves many traces of its rich medieval past.

After a pleasant walk we will continue towards **COLLOGNES LA ROUGE**, a beautiful town located between walnut and chestnut trees and characteristic for the reddish color of its houses.

We continue our trip to **MARTEL**, a beautiful town known as “the city of the seven towers”, with a rich architectural heritage.

Our last stop will be in **ROCAMADOUR**, known as a sacred city and a prominent place of pilgrimage. Located on a massive cliff where its famous sanctuary of the Black Madonna stands out. Time to enjoy this wonderful citadel. Accommodation.

### Day 04 . Rocamadour – Saint-Cirq-Lapopie- Cahors – Lauzerte- Pujols – Bordeaux.-

We will cross the Natural Park of the Causses du Quercy Region and we will arrive in **SAINT-CIRQ-LAPOPIE**. The whole city is considered as a historic monument and it is on the list of “The most beautiful villages in France”.

We take advantage of our route through the province of Lot to see another city full of art and history, **CAHORS**. Its narrow streets and monuments are testimonies of its history, from Gallo-Roman times to medieval times. With our guide we will visit one of its famous **Cha-teau** surrounded by vineyards and we will be able to taste the wines of the region (**entrance included**).

We continue to **LAUZERTE**, hanging town and important point for pilgrims, a medieval town full of charm and magic.

Before ending this wonderful route through the south of France, we will make a stop at another unique medieval town, **PUJOLS**. Surrounded by vineyards, we will walk with our guide through its flowery alleys dotted by beautiful houses. Arrival in **BORDEAUX**.
