Locality chosen by many artists as a place of residence, located on a mountain overlooking a beautiful valley with centuries-old olive fields. In the highest part, the remains of its medieval castle still remain. Houses built with rodenostone, reddish colour typical of the area. Walk with our tour guide through its quiet streets.

We leave Vilafamés heading south, crossing orange groves and the north orchard of Valencia. Arrival in the Valencian capital.



**Day 01 . Santiago De Compostela- Castro Borneiro- Camelle- Camariñas- English Cemetery- Mugia- Fisterra.-**

**Welcome to your Europamundo Trip Style!!!**

The information about the meeting place and start time of your circuit can be found on your voucher.

We leave Santiago towards **A CORUÑA**, where we will visit its port, with its famous roman lighthouse still in operation, the so-called Tower of Hercules, the Paseo do Orzán (Orzán Seafront) or the old town with María Pita Square, remembering an ancient heroin.

We continue to two archaeological sites, **CASTRO BORNEIRO** (Borneiro Celtic settlement) and **DOMBATE DOLMEN** (important Celtic and Neolithic culture examples).

Afterwards, stop at **CAMELLE** in order to know Manfred Gnadinger's house-museum, famous and peculiar German hermit artist who lived in this area.

We head to **CAMARIÑAS**, a world-famous fishing village for its famous palilleiras and their bobbin laces; time to stroll through its port and visit Cape Vilán, where we find its emblematic lighthouse in a paradisiacal environment.

After lunch we will visit the **English Cemetery** area, one of the most fateful places in the Death Coast (Costa da Morte) due to its numerous shipwrecks.

We continue to **MUXIA**, located in an impressive landscape, with its Our Lady of the Boat Sanctuary (Santuário da Virxe da Barca), and its legendary environment that our guide will explain to us.



EZARO

Later we will arrive at a magical site: **FINISTERRE**, the “Finis Terrae” for the Romans, where the world ended. We’ll walk to its lighthouse on Finisterre Cape. You can climb to the top of Facho Hill (Monte do Facho), with incredible views of rugged landscapes and stunning beaches.

We return to the village where we will have time for walk or taste the local seafood. **Accommodation.**

### Day 02 . Finisterre - Ézaro Falls - Corrubedo Dunes - Pazo Baion Winery -Cambados - Arousa Island - Pontevedra.-

We leave Finisterre and after a few kilometers we are in front of the **EZARO FALLS**, the only one in Europe of a river that flows into the sea.

We continue our journey through the **Outes Mountains** until we reach **CORRUBEDO DUNES Natural Park**, large mobile dune by the sea in a protected natural area; if you wish, we can go for a 30-minute walk.

At the end of the morning, we will have a wine experience, **visiting a wine cellar and tasting the local Albariño wine, D.O Rías Baixas, at Bodegas Conde de Albarei** in PAZO BAION (Baion Palace).

We arrive in **CAMBADOS**, capital of the wine we have just tasted. We can have lunch in one of the taverns in the old town, monumental historical-artistic complex, and visit the beautiful gothic-style Santa Mariña Dozo Church ruins.

Later we will head to the **AROUSA ISLAND**, crossing by an almost two km long bridge. From the viewpoint called O Con do Forno, the highest point in the Illa where the Punta Cabalo Lighthouse is located, we will discover one of the most beautiful sunsets in the estuary.

We finish the day arriving at **PONTEVEDRA**. Time for dinner and accommodation.

### Day 03 . Pontevedra- O Grove- Isla de A Toxa- Combarro - Pontevedra.-

Breakfast and departure to **O GROVE**, where we will take a **boat ride between “bateas” (mussels farms) with mussels and albariño wine tasting.**

After this experience, we will pass through a century-old bridge to the **A TOXA ISLAND** with its famous Spa, Grand Hotel or the Shells Chapel, completely covered with scallop shells.

Then we will visit **COMBARRO**, a fishermen and shellfish gatherers village, famous for its multiple hórreos (granaries) and cruceiros (stone path crucifixes) in its old area.

After lunch, we return to **PONTEVEDRA**, a friendly city that invites you to get lost in its medieval old town, its boardwalks and the river, an international reference for urban quality and sustainability. Time for dinner and accommodation.



### Day 04 . Pontevedra- Baiona- A Guarda- Valença- Ríver Sil Canyon- Santiago de Compostela.-

We leave Pontevedra and reach **BAIONA**. We will discover its wonderful old quarter and its fish and seafood fish market. La Pinta Caravel arrived here in 1493 with the discovery of America news. We can also visit an exact replica of the Caravel, in which it is represented as daily life was at the great navigation times.

We continue our journey to **A GUARDA**, one of the most important tourist sites in Galicia. We will visit another magical place, the **Castro de Santa Tegra or Santa Tecla** Celtic settlement, belonging to the Castrexa culture (Celtic culture), located on the mountain of the same name and privileged place from which you can see the river Minho mouth.

From A Guarda we will take a **ferry** that will take us to **Caminha, Northern Portugal**, and once there we will head to **VALENÇA**, village-fortress strategically located on the border. Free time to walk and have lunch in its lively streets.

We take our path to reach the Holy Bank area (Ribeira Sacra), land marked by the rivers Minho and Sil that, as it passes between mountains, shape this beautiful landscape.







### Day 01 . Brussels- Durbuy- Rochefort- Dinant- Orval- Bouillon- Welcome to your Europamundo Trip Style!!!

The information about the meeting place and start time of your circuit can be found on your voucher.

We will leave Brussels early in the direction of **DURBUY**, a small medieval town surrounded by forests on the banks of the Ourthe River, known as “the smallest city in the world”. It has a castle surrounded by narrow alleys full of charm and a curious park. We will walk through its cobbled streets and along the wooded path that surrounds the town.

Next, we will stop at **the Abbey of Our Lady of Saint Remy of ROCHEFORT**, located in a beautiful environment. This beautiful town has a **museum dedicated to Trappist Beers** where we will find the beers made in the abbey (**entrance included**). Rochefort also stands out for its Neo-Romanesque style Our Lady of the Visitation College Church and for the Counts Castle Ruins.



ROCHEFORT

We continue to **DINANT**, a beautiful city on the banks of the Meuse River and nestled between the rocky massif of the Ardennes, a true postcard city. We shall cross the Charles de Gaulle Bridge in order to appreciate the urban landscape, where we will be able to spot the Citadel and the impressive Collegiate Church of Our Lady.. We will have time to stroll around and after a good lunch we will take a **panoramic river cruise (entrance included)**.

We will enter the small region of Gaume to visit **the Abbey Our Lady of Orval**, one of the most beautiful in Europe and located in a natural reserve. ### Day 01 . Edinburgh.-

**Welcome to your Europamundo Trip Style!!!**

The information about the meeting place and start time of your circuit can be found on your voucher.

Departure from Edinburgh to visit the Borders, Scotland's south-eastern region. We begin with a visit to **Rosslyn Chapel (entrance fee included)**, a masterpiece of British Gothic art sculpted with whimsical figures that have led to all manner of interpretations. Owned by the Sinclair clan, Scottish landowners of Norman origins, this chapel has gained enormous fame in recent years for having inspired the famous best-seller The DaVinci Code.

From there, we will head towards the coast to discover the charming village of **BERWICK**. Its rows of Victorian houses facing the sea evokes a bygone era when this place was a popular summer destination.

Return to Edinburgh and accommodation.

## Day 02 . Edinburgh – South Queensferry - St. Andrews – Innis Gunn Brewery - Pitlochry.-

This morning, we will head north to the ancient kingdom of Fife. We will cross the Firth of Forth over the most modern of its three bridges, but not before making a brief stop at **South Queensferry** to get a detailed view of the Victorian Railway Bridge, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

We will enjoy Atholl Road, its main street, crowded with Victorian stone houses, pubs, restaurants, and shops, or stroll along the banks of River Tummel. Accommodation.

## Day 03 . Pitlochry – Dalwhinnie – Cairngorms - Inverness - Grantown-on-Spey.-

Departure from Pitlochry to visit **the Dalwhinnie Distillery**, located at the source of the River Spey, it is the highest distillery above sea level in Scotland. Or, alternatively, **the Edradour Distillery**, one of the smallest in the country with a great reputation not only for the quality of its spirit but also for the casks it ages and bottles from other distilleries which have become collector's items.

After the **tour and tasting at the distillery**, we will cross **the Cairngorms National Park** in our way to **INVERNESS**, the capital of the Highlands where we will stop for a brief visit and a lunch.

In the afternoon, we will head south to **LOCH NESS**, the most famous loch in Scotland, home to Nessie, and take a **boat trip** across its mysterious waters to disembark at the ruins of Urquhart Castle, destroyed during the Jacobite Rebellions.

### Day 01 . Ljubljana.-

**Welcome to your Europamundo Trip Style!!!**

The information about the meeting place and start time of your circuit can be found on your voucher.

Transfer to the hotel. Depending on the arrival time of your flight, the city tour of the Slovenian capital will take place today or the last day before your return flight.

**LJUBLJANA**, undoubtedly one of Europe's most welcoming capitals, is known for its lively university life and pleasant green spaces, such as the vast Tivoli Park. The curving Ljubljanica River, surrounded by charming restaurants and terraced cafés, divides the old town from the modern city. It is also called "the city of books" because of its intense cultural activity. With our guide, we will discover the main places of interest.

### Day 02 . Ljubljana- Celje- Ptuj- Maribor.-

Departure at 08.00h. Slovenia is a small country with incredible contrasts. We begin our adventure by travelling north to the Lower Styria region. With an evi-

dent influence from Austria, this is one of the most important wine-growing areas in Central Europe. We arrive in **CELJE** at around 09.00h, which is the third-largest city in the country, where we will visit its spectacular **medieval castle**, considered the most imposing in the whole of Slovenia. Situated on a hill at 500 meters high, it offers magnificent views over the city (**entrance included**). Departure at 11.00h.

At around 12.00 h, we will stop in **PTUJ**, a town on the Drava River whose fortress, built to defend itself from the Hungarians, was renovated in the Baroque period. Surrounded by vineyards, it is the oldest town in the country, a pearl to be discovered. With our guide, we will walk through its picturesque narrow streets until we reach **the Monument to Orpheus**, a five-metre-tall tombstone with mythological reliefs placed in honour of the Roman governor of the city in the II century AD and which still occupies its original site. After strolling through the centre of this oenological capital, also known for its carnival and kurent costumes, we will continue to **MARIBOR**, where we will arrive at lunchtime.

**MARIBOR** is Slovenia's second-largest city and is at the crossroads that connects Graz with Zagreb and Budapest with Venice. It was part of the Austro-Hungarian Empire until its dissolution in World War II. The city flourished as a commercial enclave and today boasts one of the most stunning historical centres in the region, which we will discover with our guide. You can enjoy the tasty local cuisine in one of the delicious traditional restaurants in the evening. Accommodation.

### Day 03 . Maribor- Kranj- Skofja Loka- Vitgar- Bled.-

A leg of our trip full of extraordinary landscapes and small towns full of beauty. We leave early towards the west of Slovenia, crossing idyllic mountainous landscapes to arrive at **KRANJ**. The capital of the Slovenian Alps is defined as Slovenia's green and cultural heart. A unique feature of the city is the river canyon that crosses its town centre. We will visit its fascinating historical part, and **the underground tunnels** hidden underneath it used as a shelter during World War II (**entrance included**).

A few kilometres from Kranj, we come across **SKOFJA LOKA**, one of the best-preserved European medieval villages with an impressive heritage, with the castle that stands out. At the top of a breath-taking cliff overlooking the lake is its magnificent castle. We include a **visit to this fortress** and a delightful **boat trip on the lake** to its famous and evocative island.

After lunch, we will visit another wonder close to Bled, the impressive **Vintgar Gorge (entrance included)**. We will walk along the canyon walls that rise up to 100 m high through a

perfectly conditioned gorge while the emerald waters of the Radovna River flows at our feet between waterfalls and natural pools. The gorge ends at the 13-metre-high Šum waterfall, whose name means 'noisy waterfall'.

After this unforgettable experience, we return to **BLED** for accommodation.

### Day 04 . Bled- Postjona Cave - Predjama Castle - Izola- Piran.-

Today we will appreciate the contrasts of this small country, as we will go down to the Adriatic coast. There, we will see cities that once were part of the Republic of Venice. Their style and characteristics are entirely different.

On the way, we will enter the tunnels and galleries of the beautiful **Postjona Caves (entrance included)**, the most popular in Europe, and part of the journey will be done on an electric train. Next to them is the majestic XVI century **Predjama Castle**, which we will also visit. In Slovenian, "jama" means cave, so its name means castle in a cave. It stands in a unique location, facing a 123-metre cliff.

In the last part of the day, the protagonist will be the Adriatic Sea. First, we will stroll through **IZOLA**, perhaps the most beautiful seaside town in Slovenia due to its narrow streets, Venetian influence, lively harbour, old churches or small restaurants, where we will have lunch.

We continue then to **PIRAN**. It is inhabited since the Classical Greek period. We will walk with our guide through its beautiful historic centre, its charming Venetian squares and along a section of its **walls (climb included)**, from which you will enjoy fabulous panoramic views over the city and its bay. Even on clear days, you can see Venice quite clearly. Accommodation in Piran.





### Day 01 . Belgrade.-


**Welcome to your Europamundo Trip Style!!!**

The information about the meeting place and start time of your circuit can be found on your voucher.

During the arrival transfer your guide will provide you with essential information about Belgrade, Serbia and your tour.

Serbia's winemaking tradition dates back to prehistoric times, and its geographical position, soil and temperature improve the potential for producing good quality wines. Its popularity was achieved in the 21st century, and at the moment, it is a fashionable drink, making its production to be in full development and modernization, aiming to provide a high-quality product. We will get to know the different wine regions and many of their winemakers during the trip, as most of their wines are produced in small and medium-sized wineries, run with care by family businesses, which we will discover throughout the trip.

## Day 02 . Belgrade- Novi Sad - Sremski Karlovci.-

After breakfast, we will depart to the cultural heritage region of **Fruska Gora**, famous not only for its vineyards but also for its beautiful landscapes, nature and monasteries. We will stop at the Orthodox monastery of **Krusedol**, from the 16th century, the most important in the region.

We will continue to the town of **SREMSKI KARLOVCI**, surrounded by vineyards, and take a walk through the region 's capital, where we will stay for two nights. In Fruska Gora, there are many small **family wineries** that we will discover with our guide **visiting two of them**. In the second one, we will also have **lunch with tasting included**.



### Day 04 . Sremski Karlovci – Topola- Kragujevac. -.-

In the morning, we will leave for the **Sumadija** region in the centre of Serbia, the historical region of the country and covered with forests. ## Day 05 . Kragujevac -Negotinska Krajina region- Felix Romuliana- Rajac - Rogljevo- Negotin.-

Today we will change wine regions. From Šumadija, we will go to **Negotinska Krajina**, in the east of the country, along the Danube River, which represents another real treasure of Serbian viticulture using its fragrant native grapes.

On the way, we will stop to visit **Felix Romuliana**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site for being one of the most interesting late Roman sites in Europe with remains of a palace complex with exceptional mosaics, baths etc.(**entrance fee included**).

The region is known for its original wine cellars called "pivnice". Several localities have this traditional type of wineries, and we will visit the two most important and best-preserved: **RAJAC and ROGLJEVO**. In both places, you will have the opportunity to taste some local wine and learn more about the uniqueness of this wine region. In one of the villages, you will also have a **local lunch included**.

After lunch we will go to the nearby town of **NEGOTIN**, next to Romania and Bulgaria borders, to enjoy the rest of the day. Here you will have the opportunity to see what provincial towns are like in Serbia. The guide will recommend where to go and what to choose from the local gastronomy. Accommodation.



## Day 06 . Negotin- Bukovo Monastery Winery - Iron Gate Gorge - Belgrade.-

The first activity planned for today will be a visit to the best wine cellar of the Serbian Orthodox monasteries. **The Bukovo monastery** is very famous for its indigenous grape varieties, one of which is the black Tamjanika grape. This wine is made only in this winery. For this **visit**, you **will be accompanied by the monks** who, as well as showing you around their monastery, will explain the whole process of making their wine, combining spirituality and winemaking in perfect harmony.

After this visit, we will take **the Iron Gates Gorge**, the biggest gorge in Europe, and Serbia's essential attractions. On the way to Belgrade, we will stop for lunch (**included in the price**) at **Kapetan Mišin breg** before visiting **the archaeological site of Lepenski Vir (entrance fee included)**, which is the first prehistoric sedentary settlement on European territory, dating from more than 6000 years ago, and the medieval fortress of Golubac (**entrance fee included**).

Arrival in Belgrade at the end of the day.





### Day 01 . Istanbul.-


**Welcome to Turkey!** Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel and accommodation.

### Day 02 . Istanbul.-

A sightseeing tour of the city. On our tour, we will include a **cable car ride up to the Pierre Loti viewpoint** and we will enter the **Mosque of Suleyman the Magnificent** (the largest in Istanbul). We will see the walls, the Golden Horn, the fishing district, and we will admire the exterior of Hagia Sophia. After the visit, we will offer tickets and a visit to the **Topkapi Palace (entrance included)**, which was the administrative centre of the Ottoman Empire, with its magnificent courtyards and its pavilions.

### Day 03 . Istanbul.-

Today we include a **boat trip on the Bosphorus** that will last about two hours. The Bosphorus is a strait that connects the Black Sea with the Sea of Marmara, which separates Istanbul into two parts: the European part and the Asian one. We will enjoy seeing the liveliness of the strait with its multitude of boats. We will pass under the two bridges that unite Europe and Asia and we will admire the palaces of the sultans, the typical wooden houses and the Ottoman villas. Free time.

### Day 04 . Istanbul- Bandirma- EPHEBUS- Kusadasi.-

We left early from Istanbul. We crossed by **fast ferry** (variable schedules according to seasons and months) the Sea of Marmara, after about two hours of crossing, we arrived at the port of **BANDIRMA** (or Yalova according to schedules). We continued route through the interior of Turkey. At the beginning of the afternoon we arrive at **EPHEBUS**, the best-preserved ancient city of Asia Minor; 2000 years ago, it had a quarter of a million inhabitants. We know **Saint John 's Basilica**, after it, the **house of the Virgin Mary** and the **archaeological site (tickets included)**. We then continue to **KUSADASI**, a popular coastal town with a lot of atmosphere, commercial life and a small castle. **Dinner** and accommodation.

### Day 05 . Kusadasi- Bodrum- Marmaris.-

We leave for **BODRUM**, a very beautiful, fortified city of Greek origin. You can visit its castle, stroll through its cosy streets full of life and tourism or go around its sports marina. After lunch, we go on our way to **MARMARIS**, another very beautiful coastal tourist enclave with its castle, its marina and its fountains. **Dinner** and accommodation.

### Day 06 . Marmaris- Dalyan- Antalya.-

We leave for **DALYAN**, an incredible place by a navigable river. We include a two-hour **boat trip** to see **LYCIA'S ROYAL TOMBS**, and still on the boat, we go on to a large lake where we stop at the thermal springs. If you want, you can bath in the warm waters or have a mud bath! Time for lunch in one of the numerous restaurants in Daylan by the river. Continuation to **ANTALYA**, we will make a brief visit to this coastal city of more than a million inhabitants, the door of Adrian, the Ottoman district and its great waterfall that falls straight into the sea. **Dinner included**.

### Day 07 . Antalya- Aspendos- Side- Karaman- Nigde.-

We leave Antalya for **ASPENDOS**, we visit the Roman theatre which many believe to be the best preserved in the world. After this in **SIDE** we can admire the Greek temple of



Apollo by the sea. Time to stroll around the port and through its streets full of life. Amidst impressive countryside we cross the Taurus Mountains, their peaks of over 3,500 metres in height are snow-covered for a large part of the year. A stop in **KARAMAN** where we visit **TARTAN EVI**, an **ancient Ottoman mansion**. Continuation to the edge of the Cappadocia region, **NIGDE**. **Dinner included**.

**Note:** Sometimes the Tartan Evi may be closed, in which case the visit would be replaced by another to a mansion of similar characteristics in Cappadocia.

### Day 08 . Nigde- Avanos- Cappadocia.-

A full day in the fantastic region of CAPPADOCIA, with its lunar landscapes, its churches and troglodyte villages. We start by visiting **GUMUSLER**, an incredible seventh century underground monastery with maybe the best Byzantine frescoes in Turkey. In **KAYMAKLI** we will see the **underground city** that could house 30,000 people (entrance included). We will visit the natural fortress of **UCHISAR (entrance included)**. After lunch, we will see the **GOREME** Valley with its open-air museum and its churches dug out of the rocks, **(entrance included)** Hotel in **AVANOS**. **Dinner included**.

### Day 09 . Cappadocia- Ihlara- Konya.-

At the far end of Cappadocia, we will visit the **IHLARA Valley**; known for the freshness of its waters, its churches and villages excavated in the rock. Then we continue our route, with a stop in an old **CARAVANSERAI** from the 13th Century before arriving in **KONYA** where we visit the **Mausoleum of Mevlana**, here we will learn about the sect of the Dervishes (**entrance included**). At night, we suggest that you attend the dance performance of the whirling dervishes in the cultural centre. **Dinner included.**

### Day 10 . Konya- Egridir-Pamukkale.-

We take a scenic road between the lakes, and get to know **EGRIDIR**, a beautiful town next to a large lake, with its walls and mosques. There's time to have lunch. We then continue to **PAMUKKALE - Hierapolis**, whose calcareous waters have created the Cotton Castle (**entrance included**). **Dinner included.**

### Day 11 . Pamukkale- Ephesus- Kusadasi.-

We leave for **EPHESUS**, the best-preserved ancient city of Asia Minor; 2000 years ago, it had a quarter of a million inhabitants. We see the **house of the Virgin Mary**, the **Basilica of Saint John** and the impressive **ruins of Ephesus (entrance included)**. We then go on to **KUSADASI**, a popular coastal town with a lot of atmosphere, commercial life and a small castle. **Dinner included.**



## Day 12 . Kusadasi- Izmir- Bursa- Istanbul.-

We leave for the city with the fourth largest population in Turkey: **IZMIR**. We see the **church of Saint Polycarp**, the oldest in the city, which reminds us of the importance of this area in early Christianity (**entrance included**). We then return to inland Turkey. Stop en route for lunch before reaching **BURSA**, whose historic centre has been declared UNESCO World Heritage, with its traditional commercial districts, mosques, religious schools, public baths ... The green mosque stands out. Arrival in **ISTANBUL** at the end of the day. **Arrival and end of services.** Our guide will drop you off at the agreed point.

**We hope you have enjoyed your circuit with Europamundo.**

The green mosque stands out. Arrival in **ISTANBUL** at the end of the day.




