Day 01 . Madrid- Ayllon- Burgos De Osma- Monasterio De Silos- Covarrubias- Burgos.-

Welcome to your Europamundo Trip Style!!!

The information about the meeting place and start time of your circuit can be found on your voucher.

We leave to the Northern Mountains of Madrid, and at the beautiful town of **AYLLÓN**, in the vicinity of the Mountains with the same name, with its red architecture and medieval atmosphere.

We continue towards **BURGO DE OSMA**, an ancient and monumental episcopal city, located in the province of Soria and known for its history and beautiful Cathedral (entrance included).

We visit the **SAINT DOMINGO OF SILOS MONASTERY (admission included)**, a place of spiritual refuge and one the most beautiful places to admire the Spanish Romanic Art, unique in Europe. Then we arrive at the noble city of **CO-**



CATEDRAL BURGOS

VARRUBIAS, with its old walled case, its typical Houses. In the Collegiate Church we can admire the triptych and also visit the tomb of Fernán Gonzalez, first count of Castilla. and its interesting vintage weapons collection. After a brief journey, arrival and accommodation in the city of **BURGOS**.

Day 02 . Burgos- Atapuerca- Lerma- Palencia.-

After breakfast time to get to know the city of **BURGOS**, crossroads; its spectacular Gothic Cathedral stands out, built for more than three centuries, where the tomb of El Cid and his wife Da. Jimena, is located, as well as the Holy Mary 's Arch and the House of Cordón.

Next we will arrive at **ATAPUERCA FIELDS (entrance included)**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, where human remains of more than 900.000 years old were discovered, the Homo Antecessor (in case of having capacity and reservation problems in the Atapuerca site, we can visit the Museum of The Evolution of Man).

We arrive at **LERMA**, with a grandiose appearance with its imposing Ducal Palace (today National Parador). We can rest and have a coffee before continuing to Land of Fields where **PALENCIA** is, the royal residence and palace where the first university of Spain was founded in 1208, and then take a walk through its beautiful streets, squares and churches. Accommodation in this city, do you dare to taste its famous Spanish omelette?

Day 03 . Palencia- Valladolid- Segovia- Madrid.-

Breakfast and departure to **VALLADOLID**, capital of The Kingdom of Castile and for 6 years of the Spanish Empire, a historical complex made up of Palaces, noble houses, churches museums and where we can also experiment tapas in its bars.

We are heading to **SEGOVIA**, another UNESCO World Heritage city. We will know its Alázar, where we will stop to take a beautiful picture, its well-preserved Roman aqueduct and its pedestrian streets. At the end of the afternoon, we continue and arrive in **MADRID**.

Arrival and end of services. Our guide will drop you off at the agreed point.



Day 01 . Lisbon . -

Welcome to your Europamundo Trip Style!!!

The information about the meeting place and start time of your circuit can be found on your voucher.

Day 02 . Lisbon . -

In the morning, we will go on a tour of the city in the morning during which we will visit Belem District which was the departure point of Portuguese sailors who crossed the oceans in the 15th century. At night we **will take Elevador Da Gloria** to go to the Barrio Alto, where after enjoying the views from its viewpoint, we can take the opportunity to walk through its typical steep streets or dine in one of the small restaurants or cafes in this place full of atmosphere and fashion.

Day 03 . Lisbon - Lagos - Cabo San Vicente - Sagres - Algarve. -

We will leave early for the south of Portugal. Beautiful landscapes crossing the long bridge over the Tagus. Arrival in the Algarve, the southern region of Portugal. We know the historic city of **LAGOS** with its port from where the Portuguese ships left for Brazil and its historic centre enclosed in its walls. Time for lunch. In the afternoon we travel to the westernmost tip of the European continent, between ravines and

frequent wind sweep we get to know **CABO SAN VICENTE**. We also have the opportunity to photograph the next fortress of **SAGRES**. After that, time in **ALBUFEIRA**, a beautiful coastal city, you can enjoy its beach or stroll through its lively historic centre. Accommodation in Albufeira or a nearby city in the **Algarve**.

Day 04 . Algarve - Faro - Mertola - Evora. -

We will travel to **FARO**, the quiet capital of the Algarve. We continue our route to the Alentejo. On the banks of the Guadiana river, we visit **MERTOLA**, an old Muslim city whose church was a mosque, and we will walk through its walls and white streets. Arrival in **ÉVORA** at lunch time and stroll through this city declared a World Heritage Site with its white streets, its Renaissance palaces and its cathedral. **We will include entrance** to the impressive Chapel of Bones, built with 5000 skeletons! If you prefer, you can rest and enjoy also in the hotel pool.

Day 05 . Évora - Marvao - Castelo de Vide - Tomar - Fátima. -

Today we travel between beautiful Alentejo landscapes. We stopped at **MARVAO**, a very picturesque small town surrounded by walls that offers us a fantastic panoramic view of the region. After that, we visit **CASTELO DA VIDE**, with its castle and its old Jewish quarter, we can visit the old synagogue (nowadays a museum) or walk through the labyrinth of alleys in the city. After lunch we continue to **TOMAR**, a city dominated by the **Convent of Christ (entrance included)**, an old castle - convent of the Templars. Arrival in **FATIMA**, one of the greatest references of the Marian cult in the world. First, we will stop at **ALJUSTREL**, the village where the three little shepherds were born and where we will be able to see Lucia 's house. Later in the **SANCTUARY OF FÁTIMA** where, if you wish, you can witness the candlelight procession (not held in winter).

Day 06 . Fátima - Oporto. -

We will travel to the north of Portugal. Arrival around eleven o'clock in the morning in **POR-TO**, the magnetic second largest city in the country known for its bridges and for the production of Port wine. We will visit its historic centre on the banks of the Douro, declared a World Heritage Site. In the afternoon, **we will take the opportunity to visit one of its old wineries**.

Day 07 . Oporto - Braga - Guimaraes - Mateus - Pinhao - Coimbra. -

Today we have beautiful landscapes in the north of Portugal. A walk - through **BRAGA**, the religious capital of Portugal with its ancient cathedral. We go up in **the oldest funicular in the world to the Sanctuary of BOM JESÚS**, where we can see beautiful views before taking the beautiful stairs to the vehicle. **GUIMARAES** was the first capital of Portugal, its Palace of the Dukes reminds us of it. Time for lunch. In the afternoon we visit the beautiful gardens of **MATEUS**, known for its wines **(entrance included)**. Beautiful landscapes full of vineyards going down to the Douro Valley. We passed through **SABROSA** place where Magellan was born. In **PINHAO** we know its wonderful train station with all its tiles, and we



include a small cruise of approximately one hour on the Douro River (**Note: From November to March the cruise will not be included, taking a journey on a local train following the river bank**). We continue to **COIMBRA**, arrival at the end of the day.

Day 08 . Coimbra - Batalha - Nazare - Obidos - Lisbon. -

Time in **COIMBRA**, the third city in Portugal with a medieval historic centre where the historic University of Coimbra is located. We suggest visiting it or walking through its steep streets full of history and charm. We continue to the south, we stop next to the **MONASTERIO DE BATALHA**, an impressive medieval building mausoleum of kings. Time to have lunch and a walk in **NAZARÉ**, a fishing and seaside town. **We include the "elevator"** that takes us up to the old city with breath-taking views of the Ocean. On the way to Lisbon, we stopped at **ÓBIDOS**, one of the most beautiful towns in Portugal, with its white streets full of flowers. **LISBON**, arrival around 7:30 p.m. **End of services**. Our guide will drop you off at the agreed point.



Day 01 . Paris- Lyons-la-foret- Rouen- Le Bec-hellouin- Honfleur- Beuvron-en-auge- Lisieux-

Welcome to your Europamundo Trip Style!!!

The information about the meeting place and start time of your circuit can be found on your voucher.

We leave Paris early in the morning to arrive and discover the **Normandy region**. The first stop will be in a charming town called **LYONS LA FORET**. A short walk through its streets with half-timbered walls, colored adobe and pink bricks creating a harmonious and typical Norman ensemble.

We continue our tour to the wonderful medieval city of **ROUEN**. It has an important historical heritage, the whole city is like an open-air museum, with its beautiful half-timbered houses, its tiny and medieval streets and its Gothic churches. We will have time to walk along with our guide and have lunch.

We continue our route to the charming village of **LE BEC HELLOUIN**, with its wooden houses and flowery streets. For a long time it was a very influential religious point, highlights the Notre-Dame du Bec abbey that still remains occupied by Benedictine monks.

We head towards the coast and we will stop at **HONFLEUR**. This maritime town invites you to discover its picturesque narrow streets and its old houses. The city has managed to preserve the traces of its rich historical past. Inspirational city of Monet and some others impressionist painters.



CLUNY

We will get going again to visit another beautiful Norman town, **BEUVRON EN AUGÉ**, located on the Cider Route. We will take a walk with our guide to contemplate the typical architecture of the region.

We finish our day in the city of Santa Teresita, patron saint of the missions: **LISIEUX**. A large number of pilgrims have as their goal the monumental Basilica dedicated to this Saint. Accommodation.

Day 02 . Lisieux – Chartres – Castle of Sully Sur Loire – Auxerre.-

In the morning, if you wish, you will have time to visit the Basilica of Santa Teresa.

We continue our route to the city of **CHARTRES**, with the elegant silhouette of its **Cathedral (entrance included)**. Religious building declared a World Heritage Site constitutes an authentic masterpiece of Gothic art. We will take a walk through its medieval neighbourhoods famous for its narrow and medieval streets, stairs, half-timbered houses, museums, beautiful exhibitions and terraces. Time for lunch before continuing to the **Castle of Sully Sur Loire (entrance included)**, a medieval fortress, classified as a historical monument, it still maintains its uniqueness thanks to its wide moat still with water, and its tall conical watchtowers. Inside we will see paintings and tapestries as well as magnificent 14th century carpentry.

From the castle, we will travel to **AUXERRE**, a city with a prestigious cultural heritage, of its Gallo-Roman, medieval, gastronomic and wine-making history. An artistic and historical city full of charming half-timbered houses. Time for a walk and accommodation.

Day 03. Auxerre – Vezeley - Noyer sur Serein – Fontenay Abbey - Flavigny Sur Ozerain – Beaune.-

We start today by visiting **VEZELAY**, a bastion of Christianity since the Middle Ages and a meeting point during the pilgrimage to San Santiago de Compostela. We will visit the **Basilica of Saint-Madeleine (entrance included)**, which was classified as a World Heritage Site by the UNESCO.

We continue our route to **NOYERS SUR SEREIN**, a small town that preserves its medieval past in its old narrow streets, picturesque squares, fortified gates and walls flanked by towers. Time to have a walk.

Next stop is among some wonderful landscapes: we will visit the **Fontenay Abbey (entrance included)**, the oldest of the Cistercian foundations that remain in France, splendidly well preserved, is part of the UNESCO World Heritage.

Not far from there is **FLAVIGNY SUR OZERAIN**. A wonderful town built on a rock around a Benedictine monastery where religious, civil and military architecture blend into one. We finish our day in **BEAUNE**, capital of Burgundy. Surrounded by ancient walls, its historic center houses outstanding monuments, beautiful Renaissance palaces, pretty half-timbered houses and beautiful interior courtyards. You will discover the city by the hand of our guide and, if you wish, you can visit a winery. Accommodation.



Day 04 . Beaune – Tournus – Cluny - Paray Le Monial – Semur en Brionnais – Nevers.-

We start our day going to the south, to **TOURNUS**, located on the banks of the Saona River. We will be able to see its abbey and its extraordinary abbey church Saint-Philibert, a jewel of Romanesque architecture.

We will also visit the **Abbey of Cluny (entrance included)**, founded in 910. The Abbey of Cluny was a place of extraordinary influence in Europe, in a political, artistic and religious aspects. With its nine high-rise barrel vaults, an elevation above three floors, its historically capitals, Cluny created and spread the Cluniac style throughout Europe. We will get to know another city with historical and artistic landmarks, **PARAY LE MONIAL**, with its well-known Chapel of the Apparitions, a site where Jesus would have appeared to Saint Marguerite-Marie and his Sacre-Coeur Basilica, one of the best exponents of Romanesque art .

After lunch we will head to one of the most beautiful villages in France, **SEMUR IN BRIONNAIS**. We will be fascinated by its colorful pinkish ochre, its medieval castle, its splendid 12th-century Romanesque church and its ancient houses.

Our last stop today will be at **NEVERS**, a historical-artistic city located on the banks of the Loire River. Dominated by the silhouette of its Gothic cathedral, it houses an important architectural heritage that will surprise you. Together with our guide we will have time to enjoy the city. Accommodation.

Day 05 . Nevers - Bourgues -Orleans - Yevre le Châtel - Moret sur Loing- Paris.-

We leave early to visit the town of **BOURGUES**. We will take a pleasant walk with our guide discovering the old city, with its cobbled streets and half-timbered houses, its Gothic and Renaissance palaces, its small squares with cafes and the shops in pedestrian streets. Highlights include the Saint - Etienne Cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and its famous Jacques-Coeur Palace, a 15th century civil building in flamboyant Gothic style.

We continue to the capital of the Loire Valley Region, **ORLEANS**, one of the most beautiful cities in France where history, Joan of Arc and the Loire River occupy a predominant place. We will visit the Sainte-Croix Cathedral with our guide, a Gothic-style architectural building.

After lunch we will leave to **YEVRE LE CHATEL**, located on a rocky spur, we will have time to walk through this charming town full of flowers and discover the medieval fortress with its towers and its walls.

We continue traveling north to visit **MORET SUR LOING**, a picturesque town that inspired many impressionist artists and painters and where every corner is a postcard.

We will go to Paris where we will finish this wonderful route.

Arrival and end of services. Our guide will drop you off at the agreed point.



Day 01 . Istanbul- Samsun- Sahinkaya Canyon- Samsun.-

Welcome to your Europamundo Trip Style!!!

The information about the meeting place and start time of your circuit can be found on your voucher.

Early morning transfer from your hotel to the airport to board a domestic flight to **SAMSUN**. Upon arrival we will go directly to the **SAHINKAYA CANYON** where we will take a boat trip through this idyllic place to enjoy its impressive natural landscapes (**entrance included**). After the walk we will go to Samsun. **Dinner** and accommodation.

Day 02 . Samsun - Ordu- Yason Church - Boztepe Hill Cable Car - Giresun - Trabzon.-

After breakfast we will go to the centre of the modern city of **SAMSUN**, located on the Black Sea coast, where we will visit the historic **ship Bandirma Vapur** that took Ataturk to the city of Samsun to start the country's war of independence in 1919 (**entrance included**).

We will continue our route to the cosmopolitan city of **ORDU**, considered one of the most beautiful in Turkey. It is said that every colour of nature can be found in Ordu. We will visit the city's beautiful pink stone carved reliefs and the **Yason**

Church at Cape Caka. Then we will go up by **cable car** to Mount Boztepe (**ticket included**) where we will admire the impressive views of the city and the Black Sea. We will continue our route to **GIRE SUN**, a city known as the homeland of cherry and the capital of hazelnut. From its castle we will be able to enjoy the beauty of the city and the Black Sea. Late in the afternoon, after having visited the city, we will head to **TRABZON**. **Dinner** and accommodation.

Day 03 . Trabzon - Sumela Monastery - Hamsikoy - Karaca Caves - Trabzon.-

Today we will know in depth one of the most extraordinary regions of Turkey. We will start in the city of **TRABZON** or Trebizond, one of the oldest inhabited cities in the world, birthplace of Suleymaniye the Magnificent. This city was a commercial port on the Silk Route and a meeting point between cultures and religions. It still preserves a beautiful fortified old town with a medieval castle. During the walk we will admire its port, the largest of The Black Sea, as well as visit the **Hagia Sophia Museum**, an important example of Byzantine architecture built between 1238 and 1263, transformed into a mosque in 1670 and completely restored as a museum in the mid-20th century (**entrance included**).

Afterwards we will visit **the Greek-Orthodox Monastery of Sumela (entrance included)**, located on a steep cliff in the Black Mountains, at an altitude of more than 300 m. It is one of the oldest in the world, founded in 386 AD during the reign of emperor Theodosius. This monastery preserves a micro-city for monks with churches, rooms, kitchens, aqueducts ... of incredible beauty.

Later on, we will go to **HAMSIKOY**, a typical town of the Black Sea where we will have time to enjoy its very famous rice with milk. We continue our route visiting a network of caves and natural wonders formed millions of years ago, the **KARACA CAVES (entrance included)**. By the end of the afternoon, we will return to our hotel in Trabzon. **Dinner** and accommodation.

Day 04 . Trabzon - Kiremitli Bridge – Uzungol Lake – Aydin-tepe - Erzurum.-

We start our day with an interesting visit to a **Black Tea Factory**, the most famous product of the Black Sea region. Continuing our route, we'll make a stop along the way to take photos of the historic **Kiremitli Wooden Bridge** and the green landscapes of the Black Sea mountains. We will arrive at **Lake Uzungol**, a place of incomparable natural beauty and a popular tourist destination. There we will have time for a walk and have lunch whilst enjoying the fantastic views of the lake at the foot of the town. Next, we will visit the un-



derground city of AYDINTEPE, built 3,000 years ago during the Roman period (**entrance included**). We will end the day by traveling towards the hinterland to arrive at the city of **ERZURUM**, located at an altitude of 2,000 m above sea level. This city was known in ancient times as Theodosiopolis. **Dinner** and accommodation.

Day 05 . Erzurum – Cift Minareli Medrasa – Palandoken Mountain - Mus – Van.-

Early in the morning we will visit the historic **Cift Minareli Medrasa Theological School**, built in 1253 during the Turkish dynasty of the Seljuks. We will continue to the tectonic-origin mountain of **PALANDOKEN**, with an altitude of 3,125 meters. It has become a famous ski resort worldwide. The next stop in our route is the city of **MUS**, an interesting city whose origin dates back to the 6th century. It has been under the successive rule of Persians, Armenians, Byzantines and Ottomans among others, and preserves two citadels and a caravansarai. We will visit its Castle and have time in the centre to enjoy its gastronomy. We will continue traveling to the countryside to get to **VAN**, a city inhabited mostly by Kurdish people, located on the shore of the Van Lake. It is the capital city of this spectacular province, flanked by the Anatolian mountains. **Dinner** and accommodation.

Day 06 . Van - Lago Van - Isla Akdamar - Istanbul.-

We will start our day with a visit of **VAN**, capital of the Urartu Kingdom. The city was rebuilt after the Battle of Van and the 1st World War between Armenians, Russians and Turks. During our visit we will see the old mosques and **visit the Van Castle**. We will discover the interesting **House of the Van Breed Cats** that, according to a legend, sailed aboard Noah 's Ark (**entrance included**).

Later we will get to **VAN LAKE**, considered the largest saline lake in the world. We will then enjoy a **boat ride (ticket included)** to **ISLA AKDAMAR**, where you will find, in an idyllic setting, the extremely beautiful **medieval Armenian Church of Akdamar**. You will be able to enjoy its exterior bas-reliefs with biblical scenes, animals and fruits, as well as very fine polychrome frescoes inside.

At the end of the visit, we will have the transfer to the airport to take an included flight to **Istanbul**.

Note: *The departure point for the return flight to Istanbul may vary, depending on the schedules of the airlines, departing from "Van, Siirt, Batman or Diyarbakir"*

Day 01 . Istanbul- Troy- Canakkale-

Welcome to your Europamundo Trip Style!!!

The information about the meeting place and start time of your circuit can be found on your voucher.

We begin our exciting itinerary to know 7 cities from the Roman province of Asia, mentioned in the Book of Revelation, which was unveiled to John the Apostle. In each of these cities there were local churches or congregations of Christians that were selected by the Lord to send a specific message to each of them in early Christianity. In addition to the religious and symbolic aspect, you will also find a unique tour of historical places and nature.

In the morning, after picking you up at your hotel, we will first go to the legendary **TROY (entrance included)**, scene of Homer's Iliad. We will enjoy a visit to the 9 sites of the city on the Hisarlik hill, and we will see the replica of the famous Trojan horse.

We will continue to **CANAKKALE**, accommodation and dinner.

Day 02 . Canakkale- Pergamon- Thyatira- Kusadasi-

In the morning, after breakfast, we will visit the first of the churches that give name to our trip, the mythical **PERGAMON**. Site of many pagan temples, Pergamon also represented a strong bastion of Christianity since the 2nd century AD, as con-

firmed by the monumental size of the Basilica of St John. It was the capital of the Hellenic kingdom and its library the second richest after Alexandria's in Egypt. We shall not forget that the parchment was invented here. We will visit the **Basilica of Saint John (The Red Basilica), the Temple of Zeus and the Emperor Trajan, the Hellenic Theatre and the place of the library (tickets included).**

After a short transfer by coach, we will arrive at the **Asclepeion of Pergamon**, one of the three most famous hospitals or "Healing Temple" in the ancient world (**entrance included**).

In the afternoon, we will reach **THYATIRA**, another of the 7 Churches (**entrance included**) mentioned in the Apocalypse. At the time, this was a small city without fortifications or acropolis, but of fundamental importance due to its strategic position on the commercial routes. It was, therefore, a city of artisans and guilds as is reflected in a passage from the Acts of the Apostles.

We continue to **KUSADASI**. Accommodation and **dinner** at the hotel.

Day 03 . Kusadasi- Sardis- Philadelphia Pamukkale.-

After breakfast, we will visit **SARDIS (entrance included)**, capital of the ancient kingdom of Lydia and the place of the church that received the fifth of the seven letters in Revelation, also known for its beautiful gymnasium and large paved synagogue.

Later, we will go to **PHILADELPHIA**, the penultimate Church (**entrance included**), considered as an example for believers and one of the favourite cities of Saint Paul and Saint John.

Then we will cross the fertile valleys that will take us to **PAMUKKALE**, known as the **Cotton Castle** for its snow-white limestone travertine (**entrance included**).

Accommodation and **dinner at the hotel**, where we can enjoy its thermal pools.

Day 04 . Pamukkale- Hierapolis- Laodicea on the Lycus- Kusadasi.-

Today an interesting stage awaits us that begins by visiting **HIERAPOLIS (entrance included)**. Mentioned in the Epistle of Saint Paul to the Colossians. Here, the Apostle Philip came to preach Christianity and is believed to have lived and been martyred by the Romans. Hierapolis is one of the great sites of Anatolia. We will explore one of the richest cemeteries in the ancient world, the Domitian main gate and the main avenue.

We will also visit the **White Travertine Waterfall of Pamukkale**, a unique place in the world, declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO (admission fee included).

We will continue to **LAODICEA ON THE LYCUS (entrance included)**, the seventh of the Seven Churches, where John called the Christians "Indifferent", "the church with a luke-



warm faith". Recent excavations are revealing the walls of what could have been a monumental church.

We end our day in **KUSADASI**. Accommodation and **dinner** at the hotel.

Day 05 . Kusadasi- Ephesus- Istanbul.-

Our last day begins after breakfast, visiting the splendid city of **EPHESUS**. Ephesus was the capital of the Roman province of Asia Minor, the site of one of the seven wonders of the world, including the Temple of Artemis, and the site of the third richest library in the ancient world, the Celsus Library. Saint Paul came to Ephesus in 54 AD. He preached, gained followers, and established the church of Ephesus. In Revelation it is referred to as "the Church that had abandoned her first love". Saint John also spent his last years here and it is the place where the Virgin Mary is said to have lived and ascended to Paradise. **Entrance included to the house of the Virgin Mary.**
