

01 THU. Amsterdam.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Arrival. Transfer to the hotel.

Welcome to Europe!!! On arrival at the airport we shall be waiting to transfer you to the hotel. You can enjoy free time until your tour starts, information about the meeting place and start time can be found on the information boards in the hotel reception area.

02 FRI. Amsterdam - Zaandse Schans - Volendam- Marken - Amsterdam.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Picturesque typical village of Volendam. Boat on the IJsselmeer lake. City tour of Amsterdam.

Today we have a very exciting day in the Netherlands. We will go to Zaandse Schans with its mills, canals and its typical houses. Next VOLENDAM, a very picturesque fishing village. A short boat trip from Volendam, will take us to MARKEN (an island that was joined to the mainland by a fixed dike), where the houses there are built on stilts. After this, we travel to AMSTERDAM where we will enjoy a panoramic visit of the city to see its narrow canals, its official buildings and parks. We will also see the technique of diamond cutting. A large part of the visit will be done on foot, the information will be given through headphones. Time for dinner in Rembrandtplein, an area with many restaurants from all corners of the world and near the red-light district with its liberal values. Return to the hotel.

03 SAT. Amsterdam- Brussels- Bruges- Paris.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Feeling Belgium.

Today we will leave for BRUSSELS, taking time in the Grand Place and making a stop to photograph the Atomium. Continuing to BRUGES, the marvellous Flemish city known as the Venice of the North. Time for lunch. Our journey will take us to France. Arriving in PARIS at the end of the day.

04 SUN. Paris.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: City tour in Paris. Climb to the second floor of the Eiffel Tower. Boat ride along the Seine. Evening transfer.

01 TUE. Côte d'Azur.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Arrival. Transfer to the hotel.

Welcome to Europe!!! On arrival at the airport we shall be waiting to transfer you to the hotel. You can enjoy free time until your tour starts, information about the meeting place and start time can be found on the information boards in the hotel reception area.

02 WED. Nice- Mónaco- Saint Tropez- Marseille.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Côte d'Azur.

Today we see the Côte d'Azur and the Mediterranean in France. We spend a short time in NICE to enjoy the Walkway of the English. We travel through stunning countryside to the Principality of MONACO; on the way we see the techniques of traditional perfume manufacturing. In the second smallest country in the world (after the Vatican), we can walk through "Le Rocher" old town, where the Prince's Palace is located. Continuation to SAINT TROPEZ, in its old fishing port we can see some of the most luxurious yachts in the world. Time to stroll and have lunch. We continue to MARSEILLES, France's second city, to see its vibrant "Vieux port" (old port).

03 THU. Marseilles- Arles- Les Beaux- Avignon- Lyon.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Provence region. Carrières de Lumière in Les Beaux.

Villages, landscapes, history, today we see some of the most beautiful places in Provence. ARLES, a world heritage city, shows us its legacy of the Roman and medieval times and reminds us of Van Gogh. In LES BEAUX, we have the chance to visit this small medieval village and we will include admission to the CARRIERES DE LUMIERE, an impressive show of art, image and sound underground, in some former quarries. Time for lunch and stroll in AVIGNON, with its immense Palais des Papes. We continue to LYON, where we can walk through the World Heritage Site old town and we will include the cable car to climb Notre Dame de Fourvière, a huge basilica from where we have a great view over the city.

04 FRI. Lyon- Tournus- La Rochepon- Beaune- Dijon.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Burgundy region. Rochepon Castle.

We will leave Lyon for Burgundy. We stop at TOURNUS, a nice little town with its huge stone door and large abbey. After this, on small roads we travel through beautiful vineyards and countryside to LA ROCHEPOT, we include admission to its powerful medieval castle. BEAUNE, time for lunch and stroll in the wine capital of Burgundy; you can visit the wine museum or

see the historic hospice. In the early afternoon, arrival in DIJON, the capital of Burgundy, with its lively streets, magnificent urban complex and many medieval and Renaissance buildings, particularly the Ducal Palace.

05 SAT. Dijon- Fontenay Abbey- Semur en Auxois- Vezelay- Paris.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Burgundy region. Admission to Fontenay abbey.

We leave Dijon for FONTENAY ABBEY, a world heritage site, where we include admission to this Cistercian centre. After this, a stop in SEMUR EN AUXOIS, a medieval city surrounded by impressive walls. Still in Burgundy, we will have time for lunch and a stroll in VEZELAY, one of France's most beautiful villages, where its immense basilica was one of the starting points of the Way of St James. In the afternoon we continue our route to PARIS - Arrival mid-afternoon.

06 SUN. Paris.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: City tour in Paris. Climb to the second floor of the Eiffel Tower. Boat ride along the Seine. Evening transfer.

Today we take a guided tour to discover the history, main boulevards and the breathtaking monuments of Paris. We end the visit at the EIFFEL TOWER. Days 1 - 6 as in Opt. 1

07 MON. Paris- Amboise.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Amboise.

We will start the day by going to the centre of Paris, to the area of the Louvre Museum. Enjoy some leisure time to explore. If you wish you have the option of visiting the Louvre Museum or we can accompany you to Berloux, one of the most complete and best-known perfumeries in Paris. At 16.30 hrs. we leave Paris for the Loire Valley. **AMBOISE**, arriving in the late afternoon, this city on the Loire River is well-known because Leonardo Da Vinci lived and died here, and it also has a large castle and a beautiful historic centre with narrow streets.

08 TUE. Amboise- Bordeaux- Lourdes.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Lourdes. Dinner included.

We continue on our way to the south of France. We cross lands of vineyards. **BORDEAUX**, time for lunch and a stroll through this city whose centre was declared a World Heritage Site. We suggest you know the Port of the Moon and the Cathedral of St Andrew. We continue towards the Pyrenees. **LOURDES**, arrival in the late afternoon. You can attend the candle procession (until the end of October) and visit the places of worship. We include dinner at the hotel for all our travellers!

09 WED. Lourdes- Saint Bertrand- Carcassonne- Andorra.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Medieval villages of St. Bertrand or Carcassonne.

Travelling parallel to the Pyrenees, we stop in **SAINT BERTRAND**, a medieval village hanging on the mountainside, dominated by its great cathedral. Time for a stroll before going on to **CARCASSONNE**, a city surrounded by beautiful walls. We continue through the Pyrenees on a journey between often snow-capped summits, and into the small country of **ANDORRA**. Dinner included.

10 THU. Andorra- Montserrat- Barcelona.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Catalonia region. Montserrat Monastery. Rack train climb.

Free time in **ANDORRA** for shopping and exploring. After lunch, we continue to Catalonia. The mountain countryside leads us to the impressive site of the **MONT-SERRAT MONASTERY**, where you will go up the mountain on a **rack train** to see its fantastic scenery. Following this we will continue to **BARCELONA**, arriving in the late-afternoon.

11 FRI. Barcelona.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Barcelona city tour, "Spanish Village" visit and evening transfers to Las Ramblas district.

Today we will explore Barcelona, an impressive city right on the Mediterranean Sea. Starting with an informative **city tour with a local expert** (note: If the group has fewer than fifteen people, explanations can be given by

our guide.) We also visit the city's historic central area with its Gothic neighbourhood dating back to the Middle Ages. We will visit the area where the Olympic Games took place. We will get the chance to see La Sagrada Familia Basilica; the masterpiece designed by the architect Gaudí. Following this, we include the **entry ticket to visit 'Poble Espanyol'** (meaning 'Spanish Village'). This open-air architectural museum is situated in one of the most emblematic areas of Barcelona. Enjoy Spanish craftsmanship and discover the architectural styles, traditions and folklore of the different communities in Spain. Take some free time to explore the city on your own. In the evening we provide **transfers to Las Ramblas and Plaza Catalunya** area for dinner, where you can select from a great variety of restaurants. Return to hotel.

12 SAT. Barcelona.-

After breakfast, end of our services.

(OPT. 3) FRANCE, ANDORRA AND SPAIN

Days 1 - 11 as in Opt. 2

12 SAT. Barcelona - Peniscola - Valencia - Madrid.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Peniscola, a beautiful walled town combined with a castle on the sea. Discover Valencia's City of Arts and Sciences. Night transfer in Madrid.

Travelling south, we follow the Mediterranean stopping in **PENISCOLA**, a small walled medieval town surrounded by the sea, time for a stroll. We continue to **VALENCIA** where we will have time for lunch in its historic centre, followed by a coach tour of the avant-garde "City of Sciences" designed by the architect Calatrava. We continue to **MADRID**, arriving at the end of the day. We head to **Plaza Mayor**, where we can relax at some typical taverns.

Note: If the number of travellers from Valencia to Madrid is low, the trip may be done by high-speed train.


13 SUN. Madrid.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Madrid city tour. Stroll through the Retiro Park. Visit to the Plaza de Toros de las Ventas bullring. Evening transfer.

The morning starts with a **comprehensive tour** through the centre of Madrid including Paseo del Prado, Cibeles, Neptuno, the Gate of Alcalá, Plaza de Colón and Plaza Mayor. We then visit to Retiro Park, an oasis in the city centre, where we will see the lake and the Glass Palace. A visit to **Las Ventas Bullring (admission included)** is next, this is one of the most famous bullrings in the world where we will learn about the tradition of "corridas" in the Bullfighting Museum. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon at leisure. At sunset we provide a **transfer to Plaza de Oriente**, opposite the Royal Palace, an elegant and bustling area with many restaurants serving different cuisines such as local Spanish food, international, and Chinese. Enjoy a pleasant dinner of your choice, then return to hotel together.

14 MON. Madrid.-

02 THU. Dublin.-**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Dublin sightseeing.**

Today we will have a **sightseeing tour of Dublin**, Ireland's peaceful capital city. We will enjoy a stroll on the banks of River Liffey, visiting its parks, its old university and its lively downtown streets. We will stroll around Trinity College. In the afternoon enjoy some leisure time.

03 FRI. Dublin- Powerscourt- Kilkenny- Cashel- Cork.-**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Powerscourt gardens, Rock of Cashel, dinner included in Cork.**

In the morning we will depart from Dublin heading to **POWERSCOURT** which is located near-by. We will visit its magnificent gardens, designed in the 18th century and considered the most beautiful gardens in Ireland. Admire its fountains, Japanese Gardens, and its pet cemetery. Afterwards, we will travel to **KILKENNY**, here we will have time for lunch and to stroll around this lively town. Further south, we will stop to visit the impressive **Rock of CASHEL** (**entrance included**), a medieval fortress that symbolizes the fight of Irish people against England. We will arrive in **CORK** around mid-afternoon. Time for a stroll in the centre of Ireland's second largest city. **Dinner included**.

04 SAT. Cork- Kinsale- Killarney- Adare- Limerick.-**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Kinsale, Killarney, carriage tour and cruise in National Park. Dinner in Limerick.**

We will depart for **KINSALE**. Making a stop by Charles Fort to admire its great views of the ocean right by the 17th century fortress. Time in the historic centre of **KINSALE**, a seaside town, considered by many as one of the most beautiful coastal towns in Ireland. Afterwards, we will travel to **KILLARNEY**, a tourist town in the heart of Ireland. Time for lunch and a walk around, we will also enjoy a romantic **horse and carriage tour of its national park (included)**. The horse and carriage tour will take us to **Ross Castle** which offers wonderful views by the lake. We include a short cruise to enjoy the beautiful views. Continuing, a brief stop in **ADARE**, a small village that preserves its picturesque traditional thatched-roof cottages and the ruins of the old abbey. Mid-afternoon we will arrive in **LIMERICK**. Time to stroll around its centre where you will have the opportunity to visit its castle, walk along the river, its cathedral or discover its shopping centre. **Dinner included**.

05 SUN. Limerick - Bunratty- Cliffs of Moher- Galway.-**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Folk Park in Bunratty, Poulnabrone Dolmen, Cliffs of Moher.**

Today we will visit **FOLK PARK** in **BUNRATTY** (**ticket included**), a wonderful park where we can learn about how life was in Ireland in the past with its typical cottages and old markets. Its castle stands, accurately reproducing how life was in the Middle Ages. We will continue to **CAHERCONNELL** where the **Poulnabrone Dolmen** is found. We may get the chance to see an exhibition of how dogs shepherd sheep. Afterwards, we will visit the impressive **Cliffs of Moher** which overlook the ocean, those who wish can walk to O'Brien's Tower (**entrance included**). Our route continues through Burren National Park which displays amazing landscapes. Finally arriving in **GALWAY**.

06 MON. Galway- Cong- Clonmacnoise- Dublin.-**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Monastic ruins in Clonmacnoise.**

We will depart for **CONG**, a small picturesque village located in a magnificent lake area. We will visit the ruins of the Royal Abbey and walk around **Ashford Castle**, a gorgeous medieval castle that has been turned into a hotel. We will travel to **CLONMACNOISE**, where after lunch, we will visit its monastic ruins (**ticket and visit included**). We will depart for **CONG**, a small picturesque village located in a magnificent lake area. We will visit the ruins of the Royal Abbey and walk around **Ashford Castle**, a gorgeous medieval castle that has been turned into a hotel. We will travel to **CLONMACNOISE**, where after lunch, we will visit its monastic ruins (**ticket and visit included**). We will resume our journey back to **DUBLIN**, where we will arrive in the late afternoon.

07 TUE. Dublin- Caernarfon- Liverpool.-**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHT: Ferry from Ireland to Wales. Maritime landscapes. Caernarfon.**

We will board a **fast ferry** in the early morning. After a journey of two or three hours, we will arrive to **Wales**. We will visit **CAERNARFON**, a World

Heritage site by the sea overlooked by an impressive castle. There will be time for lunch and a stroll. We continue to **LIVERPOOL**, where you will have a chance to visit The Beatles Story Exhibition.

08 WED. Liverpool- Stratford- Oxford- London.-**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHT: Shakespeare's hometown. Oxford.**

Today we explore Central England. We will visit **STRATFORD UPON AVON**, Shakespeare's hometown. Time to take some lunch and a stroll.
