01 THU. Amsterdam.-

Welcome to Europe!!! Upon arriving at the airport we will be waiting to **transfer you to your hotel**. You can enjoy free time until your tour starts. Please, check the informative posters placed at the hotel reception area which have all the information about your upcoming services such as meeting place, time and the guide's name.

02 FRI. Amsterdam - Zaanse Schans - Volendam- Marken- Amsterdam.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Picturesque typical village of Volendam. Boat on the IJsselmeer lake. City tour of Amsterdam.

Today we have a very exciting day in the Netherlands. We will go to **Zaanse Schans** with its mills, canals and its typical houses. Next **VOLEDAM**, a very picturesque fishing village. A short **boat trip** from Volendam, will take us to **MARKEN** (an island that was joined to the mainland by a fixed dike), where the houses there are built on stilts. After this, we travel to **AMSTERDAM** where we will enjoy a panoramic visit of the city to see its narrow canals, its official buildings and parks. We will also see the technique of **diamond cutting**. A large part of the visit will be done on foot, the information will be given through headphones. Time for dinner in **Rembrandtplein**, an area with many restaurants from all corners of the world and near the red-light district with its liberal values. Return to the hotel.

03 SAT. Amsterdam- Brussels- Bruges- Paris.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Belgium.

Today we will leave for **BRUSSELS**, taking time in the Grand Place and making a stop to photograph the Atomium. Continuing to **BRUGES**, the marvelous Flemish city known as the Venice of the North. Time for lunch. Our journey will take us to France. Arriving in **PARIS** at the end of the day.

04 SUN. Paris.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Transfer to Versailles Palace. Funicular ride included to Montmartre district. City tour in Paris.

We will leave Amsterdam for Germany. **HAMELIN**, a picturesque German town whose streets and shops bring us into legend of The Pied Piper of Hamelin, a children's story written by The Grimm Brothers. We will then continue and stop in **MARIENBORN**, situated on the former border that separated east and west Germany up until 1990. We will visit a museum to learn more about it. Lastly, we will head to **BERLIN**. Evening arrival.

04 SUN. Berlin.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: City tour of Berlin. We visit the Holocaust Memorial and the Berlin Wall Museum.

Ease your way into the local culture with a **guided visit** of Germany's incredible capital, Berlin. We shall visit the historic center, Museum Island, the Reichstag, the Brandenburg Gates and the city's magnificent parks. We continue our visit by stopping at the **Holocaust Memorial and the Berlin Wall Museum**. This visit helps us to understand the difficult situation the city experienced during the Twentieth Century. Time to explore the city. 05 MON. Berlin - Dresden - Prague.-

Time to explore some of the impressive palaces and to have lunch at one of its many restaurants and coffee shops. Later, we depart for the **Czech Republic. Prague** - Arrival. (OPT. 1) CROSSING FRANCE

01 TUE. Blue Coast.-

Welcome to Europe!!! Upon arriving at the airport we will be waiting to **transfer you to your hotel**. You can enjoy free time until your tour starts. Please, check the informative posters placed at the hotel reception area which have all the information about your upcoming services such as meeting place, time and the guide's name.

02 WED. Nice- Mónaco- Saint Tropez- Marseilles.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Côte d'Azur. Today we see the Côte d'Azur and the Mediterranean sea in France.

We spend a short time in **NICE** to enjoy the "Promenade des Anglais" (Walkway of the English). We travel through stunning countryside to the Principality of **MONACO**; on the way we get to see the techniques of traditional perfume manufacturing. In the second smallest country in the world (after the Vatican), we can walk through "Le Rocher's" old town, where the Princes' Palace is located. Continuation to **SAINT TROPEZ**, in its old fishing port we can see some of the most luxurious yachts in the world. Time to stroll and have lunch. We continue to **MARSEILLES**, France's second city, to see its vibrant "Vieux port" (old port).

03 THU. Marseilles- Arles- Les Beaux- Avignon- Lyon.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Provence region. Carrieres de Lumiere in Les Beaux.

Villages, landscapes, history, today we see some of the most beautiful places in Provence. **ARLES**, a world heritage city, shows us its legacy of the Roman and medieval times and reminds us of Van Gogh. In **LES BEAUX**, we have the chance to visit this small medieval village and we will **include admission** to the **CARRIERES DE LUMIERE**, an impressive show of art, image and sound underground, in some former quarries. Time for lunch and stroll in **AVIGNON**, with its immense Palais des Papes. We continue to **LYON**, where we can walk through the World Heritage Site old town and we will include the **cable car** to climb Notre Dame de Fourviere, a huge basilica from where we have a great view over the city.

04 FRI. Lyon- Tournus- Beaune- Savigny- Dijon.-

HIGHLIGHTS: Burgundy region. Savigny Castle.

We will set off from Lyon and head to the Burgundy region. We stop at **TOURNUS**, a quaint little town with an imposing stone gate and a large abbey. After that, we will travel to **BEAUNE**. Time to have lunch and explore a bit through the wine capital of Burgundy. We recommend you to visit the wine museum or the historic hospice. Next, we

will visit the **CASTLE OF SAVIGNY** situated in the heart of this winemaking region. The castle was built in the 15th century and houses some extraordinary museums (museum of motorbikes, racing cars, planes and helicopters!). We continue to **DIJON**, capital of Burgundy, which boasts of lively streets as well as numerous medieval and Renaissance buildings, among which, the palace of the dukes stands out.

05 SAT. Dijon- Fontenay Abbey- Semur en Auxois- Vezelay- Paris.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Burgundy region. Admission to Fontenay abbey.

We leave Dijon for **FONTENAY ABBEY**, a world heritage site, where we **include admission** to this Cistercian center. After this, we will make a stop in **SEMUR EN AUXOIS**, a medieval city surrounded by impressive walls. Still in Burgundy, we will have time for lunch and a stroll in **VEZELAY**, one of France's most beautiful villages, where its immense basilica was one of the starting points of the Way of St James. In the afternoon we continue our route to **PARIS**. Arrival in the evening.

06 SUN. Paris.-

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Transfer to Versailles Palace. Funicular ride included to Montmartre district. City tour in Paris.

Early in the morning, we will leave for **Versailles**, the immense palace of the kings of France. After that, we will return to Paris at lunch time where we provide a transfer to the **Montmartre district**. DAYS 1 – 6 AS IN OPT. 1
07 MON. Paris– Tours.–

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Optional activities or free time in Paris. Travel to Tours, beautiful historic town.

Today, our guide will offer you some optional activities to complete your visit to Paris: the Louvre Museum or a boat trip on the Seine river. Otherwise, you can use this time to explore at your own leisure.

At around 17:30h we will leave Paris for the Loire Valley. We will arrive in **TOURS**, regional capital of the Loire, in the late afternoon. We recommend you use your time here to take a stroll and dine in the beautiful historic downtown.

08 TUE. Tours– Bordeaux– Lourdes.–

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Lourdes. Dinner included.

Today we will travel to the south of France across fragrant vineyards. We arrive in **BORDEAUX** whose town centre was declared a World Heritage Site. Here we will have time to have lunch and explore. We suggest that you visit the Port of the Moon and St Andrew's Cathedral. We will then continue our trip and head towards the Pyrenees. **LOURDES**, arrival in the late afternoon. You can attend the candle procession (which takes place from late March until the end of October) and visit places of worship. We include the **dinner** at the hotel for all of our passengers.

09 WED. Lourdes– Saint Bertrand– Carcassonne– Andorra.–

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Medieval villages of St. Bertrand and Carcassonne. Dinner included.

Skirting the Pyrenees, we will stop in **SAINT BERTRAND**, a medieval village perched on the mountainside, dominated by its great cathedral. Time for a stroll before travelling on to **CARCASSONNE**, a city surrounded by beautiful walls. We continue through the Pyrenees on a journey between the, often, snow-capped summits, and cross into the small country of **ANDORRA**. **Dinner included.**

10 THU. Andorra– Montserrat– Barcelona.–

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Catalonia region. Montserrat Monastery. Rack train climb.

We will have free time in **ANDORRA** for shopping and exploring. After lunch, we will continue our trip and head to Catalonia. The mountain countryside leads us to the impressive site of the **MONTSERRAT MONASTERY**, where you will go up the mountain on a **rack train** to see its fantastic scenery. Following this we will continue to **BARCELONA**, arriving in the late afternoon.

11 FRI. Barcelona.–

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Barcelona city tour. "Spanish Village" visit and evening transfer to Las Ramblas district.

Today we will explore Barcelona, an impressive city right on the Mediterranean Sea. Starting by an informative **city tour with a local expert** (note: If the group has fewer than fifteen people, explanations can be given by our guide.) We will also visit the city's historic central area with its Gothic

neighborhood dating back to the Middle Ages. We will visit the area where the Olympic Games took place. We will also get the chance to see La Sagrada Familia Basilica, the masterpiece designed by the architect Gaudí.

Following this, we include the **entry ticket to visit 'Poble Espanyol'** (meaning "Spanish Village"). This open-air architectural museum is situated in one of the most emblematic areas of Barcelona. Enjoy the Spanish craftsmanship and discover the architectural styles, traditions and folklore of the different regions that make up Spain. You will then have some free time to explore the city at your own leisure. In the evening we provide a **transfer to Las Ramblas and the Plaza Catalunya** area for dinner, where you can choose from a wide variety of restaurants. We will return to the hotel in the late evening.

12 SAT. Barcelona.–

After breakfast, end of our services.

(OPT. 3) FRANCE, ANDORRA AND SPAIN
DAYS 1 – 11 AS IN OPT. 2

12 SAT. Barcelona – Peniscola – Valencia – Madrid.–

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Peniscola, Valencia's City of Arts and Sciences. Evening transfer in Madrid.

We will journey south along the Mediterranean, making a special stop in **PENISCOLA**, a small walled town on the shores of the sea and where we have time for a stroll. We will then travel to **VALENCIA**, the third largest city in Spain. After time for lunch in its historic city center, at 16.30hrs, we will continue our route to Madrid after passing through the avant-garde **City of Arts and Sciences** of Valencia where we can take a picture. Arrival to **MADRID** at the end of the day and **transfer to the Plaza Mayor** where we can relax at some typical taverns.

Note: Depending on the number of passengers, the journey between Valencia and Madrid may be done by high-speed train.

13 SUN. Madrid.–

TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Madrid city tour. Stroll through the Retiro Park. Visit to the Las Ventas bullring. Evening transfer.

The morning starts with a **comprehensive tour** through the center of Madrid including the Paseo del Prado, Cibeles, Neptuno, the Gate of Alcalá, Plaza de Colón and Plaza Mayor. We then will visit Retiro Park, an oasis in the city center, where we will see the lake and the Glass Palace. A visit to **Las Ventas Bullring (admission included)** is next. This is one of the most famous bullrings in the world where we will learn about the tradition of the "corridos" at the Bullfighting Museum. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon at your own leisure. At sunset we will provide a **transfer to Plaza de Oriente**, opposite the Royal Palace, an elegant and bustling area with many restaurants serving different cuisines, such as local Spanish food, international and Chinese. Enjoy a pleasant dinner of your choice. At the end of the evening we will return to the hotel.

14 MON. Madrid.–

02 THU. Dublin.-
TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Dublin sightseeing.

Today we will have a **sightseeing tour of Dublin**, Ireland's peaceful capital city. We will enjoy a stroll on the banks of River Liffey, visiting its parks, its old university and its lively downtown streets. We will stroll around Trinity College. In the afternoon enjoy some leisure time.

03 FRI. Dublin- Powerscourt- Kilkenny- Cashel- Cork.-
TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Powerscourt gardens, Rock of Cashel, dinner included in Cork.

04 SAT. Cork- Kinsale- Killarney- Adare- Limerick.-
TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS: Kinsale, Killarney, carriage tour and cruise in National Park. dinner in Limerick.

We will depart for **KINSALE**. Making a stop by Charles Fort to admire its great views of the ocean right by the 17th century fortress. Time in the historic centre of **KINSALE**, a seaside town, considered by many as one of the most beautiful coastal towns in Ireland. Afterwards, we will travel to **KILLARNEY**, a tourist town in the heart of Ireland. Time for lunch and a walk around, we will also enjoy a romantic **horse and carriage tour of its national park (included)**. The horse and carriage tour will take us to **Ross Castle** which offers wonderful views by the lake. We include a **short cruise** to enjoy the beautiful views. Our route continues through Burren National Park which displays amazing landscapes. Finally arriving in **GALWAY**.
