**02 TUE. Stockholm.-**

**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS:** Stockholm sightseeing.

Today we take a **panoramic tour** of this very beautiful capital city built on 13 islands joined together. We will see the Gamla Stand or the "City between the Bridges", the old quarter of the city, full of life where there are many monumental buildings such as the Nobel Museum, alongside the main square of Stortorget, which pays tribute to the winners of the Nobel Prizes, the Cathedral and the Royal Palace. Whenever possible, we will enjoy a pretty view from the Fjällgatan viewpoint. Then leisure time. We recommend visiting the museums and parks. Optionally, we suggest a visit to the City Hall and to the Vasa museum.

This is one of the largest memorial complexes in Europe built to commemorate the victims of Nazism. Free-time in the afternoon.

**09 TUE. Riga – Rundale Palace – Hill of Crosses – Trakai – Vilnius.-**

**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS:** Rundale palace, Hill of crosses, Trakai castle. Lunch included.

We will depart for **LITHUANIA** early in the morning. On our way there, we will visit the **BAROQUE PALACE OF RUNDALE**, built by the same architect who designed Saint Petersburg's Hermitage Museum. We will cross over into **Lithuania**. This country has a strong Catholic influence, highlighted by the impressive **HILL OF CROSSES**, thousands of crosses of all sizes. **Lunch included** will be taken on route. Afterwards, we will visit **TRAKAI**, a gorgeous castle located on an island in a lake, close to Vilnius. Ending the day in **VILNIUS**. **Note:** Depending on the duration of sunlight, the visit to Trakai may take place on Wednesday after visiting the city.

**10 WED. Vilnius.-**

With a **local guide** we begin the panoramic visit of this beautiful city crossed by the Neva River and built on 40 islands. St Petersburg is the second most important city in Russia and capital of the Russian Empire. This imperial city reveals the history of the Russian tsars through its museums, palaces, and architectural wealth. The visit includes the **Peter and Paul Fortress (entrance included)**, origin of the city. The city is surrounded by numerous palaces. We take an excursion, with a guide and tickets, to the **PETERHOF PALACE**. This UNESCO heritage of mankind known as the "Russian Versailles" with magnificent fountains and gardens was one of the residences of the Tzars.

**09 TUE. Saint Petersburg.-**

**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHT:** Hermitage Museum.

Today we have a visit to the **Hermitage Museum**, a fantastic art museum located in the building that was the Tsars' Winter Palace (**visit with guide and tickets**). Enjoy a free afternoon at leisure.

**10 WED. St. Petersburg.-**

After breakfast, **transfer to the airport** and end of our services.

**(OPT. 2) STOCKHOLM TO MOSCOW**

**DAYS 1 - 8 AS IN OPT. 1**

**09 TUE. St. Petersburg- Moscow.-**

**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHT:** Hermitage Museum. High speed train to Moscow.

Today we have included the visit to the **Hermitage Museum**, with a guide, a fantastic art museum located in the building that was the Tsars' Winter Palace. In the afternoon we take the "Sapsan", the modern **high-speed train**, and in four hours we cover the nearly 800 km separating the two cities, arriving in **MOSCOW** and transferring to our hotel.

**10 WED. Moscow.-**

**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHT:** City tour of Moscow with entrances to Kremlin and its main cathedrals.

We will start our day with an exciting **visit to Russia's huge capital city**. This city unites past, present and future in a very unique way. We will visit the immense avenues, elegant shopping areas, the Red Square where Lenin's Mausoleum is, **Saint Basil's Cathedral**, the Cathedral of Christ the Savior. We will also enter the **Kremlin** with a visit to **two of its main cathedrals**. We will try (not guaranteed) to coincide with the ceremonial military parade in Sobornaya Square. Enjoy the afternoon at leisure.

**11 THU. Moscow.-**

**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHT:** Viewpoint over Moscow. Great Patriotic War Museum.

We will learn more about the history of Russia and its capital. We will pass by the **university viewpoint**, with its fantastic view over the city where newly married couples leave flowers (we could go to the viewpoint after Saturday's visit instead of Sunday) and we will get to know (**including entry**) the **Great Patriotic War Museum (World War II)** that also shows us many aspects of the Soviet period. Free afternoon.

**12 FRI. Moscow.-**

After breakfast, **transfer to the airport** and end of our services.

**(OPT. 3) STOCKHOLM TO MOSCOW AND KAZAN**

**DAYS 1 - 11 AS IN OPT. 2**

**12 FRI. Moscow- Vladimir- Gorokhovets- Nizhny Novgorod.-**

**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHT:** Cathedral in Vladimir. Lunch included. Forests, pretty scenery around the hills of Gorokhovets. Volga district. Dinner included.

We leave Moscow early and travel towards **VLADIMIR**, here we visit with a **local guide** the majestic **Cathedral of the Assumption (entrance included)** that forms part of UNESCO's World Heritage. We will then take time for **lunch (included)**. We continue eastwards, stopping in the small town of **GOROKHOVETS**, its walled Kremlin, great views, 17th century monastery, and surroundings that seem to divert from time. We go on to **NIZHNY NOVGOROD**, the capital of the federal district of Volga, the fifth most populated city in Russia and the place where Maximo Gorki was born. We suggest strolling walk through its lively streets. Dinner at the hotel and accommodation. **Dinner included.**

**13 SAT. Nizhni Novgorod- Makarjevo- Cheboksary.-**

**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS:** Cable car in Nizhni, Makarievo Monastery, Ferry on the river Volga. Lunch included.

We will leave Nizhni on a cable car that flies over the Volga. Leaving the busy roads behind, we continue and encounter large plains, fir forests, lakes, and villages of wooden houses. **MAKARIEVO** shows us its great 15th century monastery on the banks of the Volga, a beautiful place virtually untouched by tourism. We cross the river **Volga by ferry** (a crossing of around 20 minutes, cargo ferries cross the river, in very limited conditions). **Lunch included.** We continue to **CHEBOKSARY**, the capital of the **Republic of Chuvashia**, a beautiful and tidy city on the banks of the Volga. Its population speaks Chuvashian, a language of Turkish origin. On arrival, enjoy a small **folkloric show** (if the group is under 12 people, this show is not provided).

**14 SUN. Cheboksary- Yoshkar- Ola- Svijaschk- Kazan.-**

**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHT:** Tour of Svijaschk. Lunch included.

We leave for **YOSKHAR-OLA**, the capital of the **Republic of Mari-El**. Here the inhabitants, who lived in the forests for centuries, speak a very ancient language derived from Hungarian and Finnish. Its urban centre has been completely transformed in recent years; and is now one of incredible beauty. Here we will take our **included lunch**. We go on towards the Tartar Republic. We visit **SVIJASCHK**, an island on the river Volga; declared UNESCO World Heritage, and inhabited in the times of Ivan the Terrible. We will take a walk with a **local guide**, among its churches and its ancient wooden dwellings. Continuing to **KAZAN**, and to the hotel.

**15 MON. Kazan.-**

**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHTS:** city tour of Kazan.

A full day in **KAZAN**, the **Tartar capital**, and a city with just over a million inhabitants. Enjoy visiting with a **local guide** the **Kremlin (entrance included)** and the city center in which the mosques rub shoulders with the Orthodox churches. We will also see the House of Lenin (only on the outside, as it is closed on Mondays), a pleasant early 20th-century traditional dacha. The afternoon is free time to explore independently.

**16 TUE. Kazan.-**

After breakfast, **transfer to the airport** and end of our services.

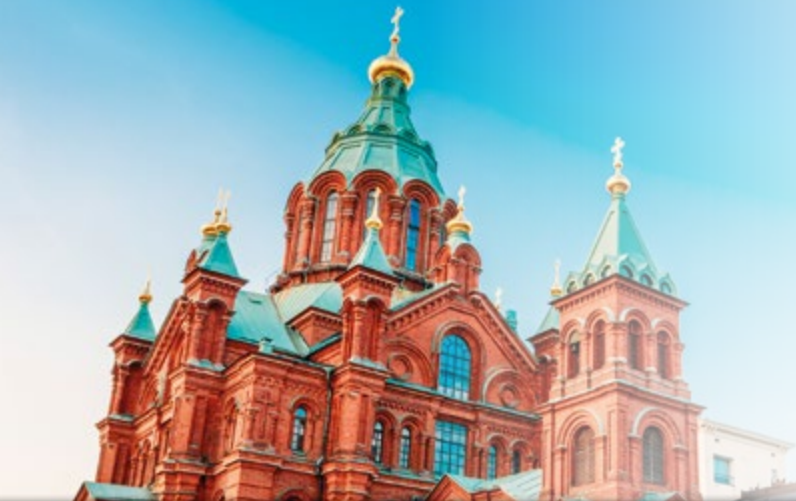

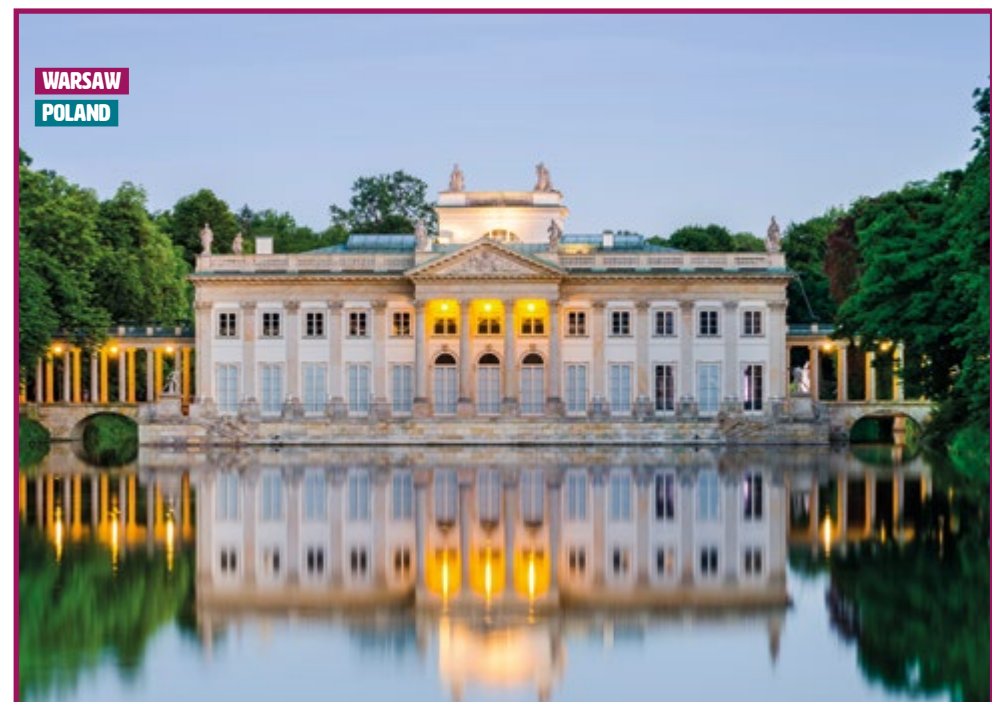

We continue our journey to **NOVGOROD**, an exciting city that was one of Russia's most important political and cultural centers. 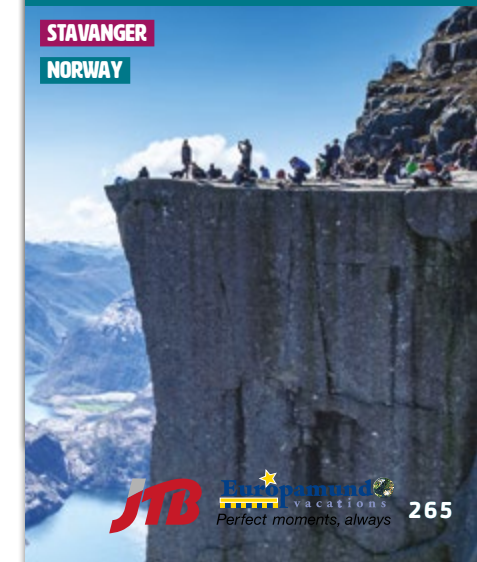

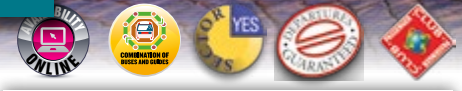

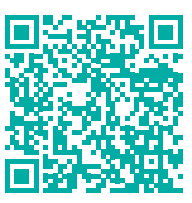

01 THU. Berlin.-

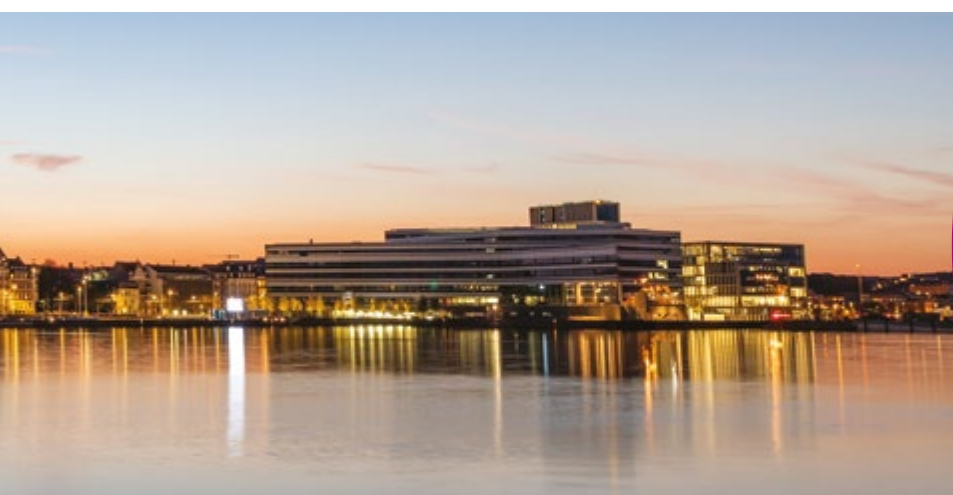

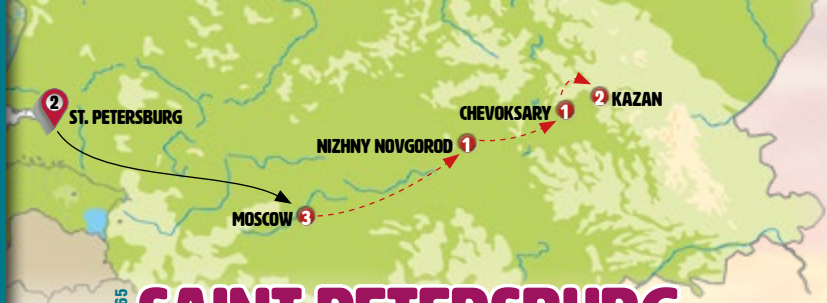

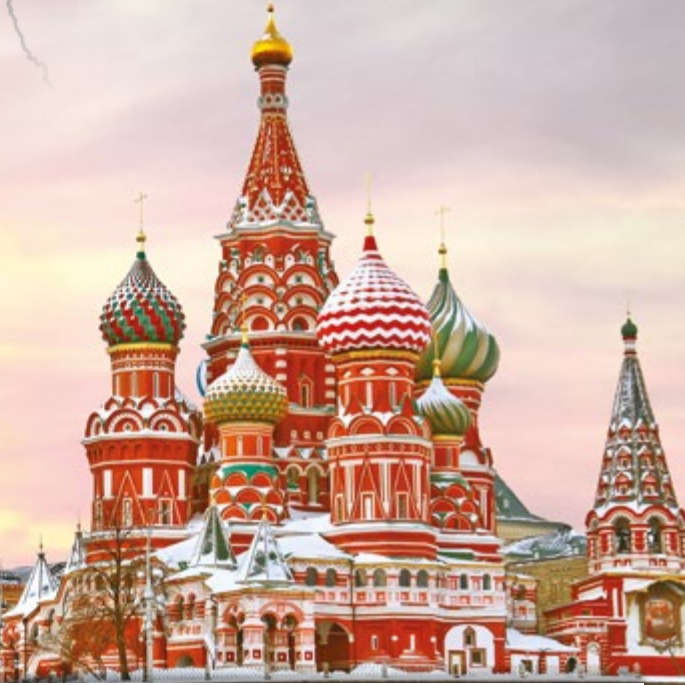

Enjoy visiting with a **local guide** the **Kremlin (entrance included)** and the city center in which the mosques rub shoulders with the Orthodox churches. We will also see the House of Lenin (only on the outside, as it is closed on Mondays), a pleasant early 20th-century traditional dacha. The afternoon is free time to explore independently.

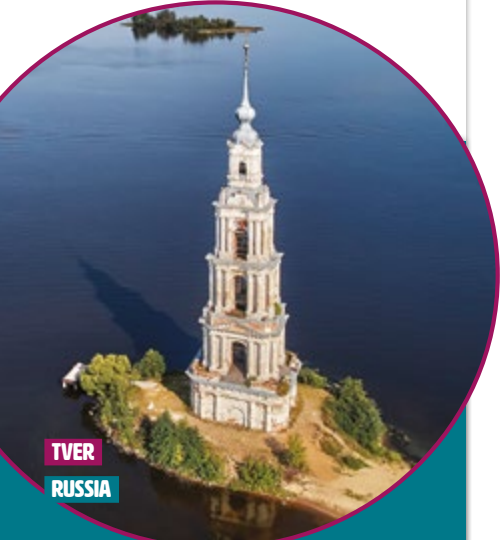

**01 SUN. St. Petersburg.-**  
**Welcome to Europe!!!** Upon arriving at the airport we will be waiting to **transfer you to your hotel.** You can enjoy free time until your tour starts. Please, check the informative posters placed at the hotel reception area which have all the information about your upcoming services such as meeting place, time and the guide's name.

**02 MON. St. Petersburg.-**  
**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHT:** Panoramic visit of St. Petersburg including Peter and Paul Fortress. Excursion to Peterhof Palace.

With a **local guide** we begin the panoramic visit of this beautiful city crossed by the Neva River and built on 40 islands. St Petersburg is the second most important city in Russia and capital of the Russian Empire. This imperial city reveals the history of the Russian tsars through its museums, palaces, and architectural wealth. The visit includes the **Peter and Paul Fortress (entrance included)**, origin of the city. The city is surrounded by numerous palaces. We take an excursion, with a guide and tickets, to the **PETERHOF**

**PALACE.** This UNESCO heritage of mankind known as the "Russian Versailles" with magnificent fountains and gardens was one of the residences of the Tzars.

**03 TUE. Saint Petersburg.-**  
**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHT:** Hermitage Museum.

Today we have a visit to the **Hermitage Museum**, a fantastic art museum located in the building that was the Tsars' Winter Palace (**visit with guide and tickets**). Enjoy a free afternoon at leisure.

**04 WED. St. Petersburg- Novgorod- Valday-Tver.-**

**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHT:** Russian plain, woodlands and lakes. Novgorod. Lunch and dinner included.

We continue our journey to **NOVGOROD**, an exciting city that was one of Russia's most important political and cultural centers. We will **visit its Kremlin (guide and entrance included)**, the former market district, the court of Yaroslav. **Lunch included.** Followed by a relaxing lunch. Then to **VALDAY**, a picturesque little city by a lake. We will visit the ancient monastery on an island in the lake before going on to **TVER. Dinner included.**

**05 THU. Tver- Sergei Posad-Suzdal.-**

**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHT:** Along tiny roads to see the rural areas of Russia, passing many charming villages on our way. Tchaikovsky's house. Lunch and dinner included.

We start the day with a stroll in **TVER**, a city on the banks of the Volga River that was the center of a small state that was Moscow's main rival. After this, we will see some of the cities of the **GOLDEN RING**. A stop in **KLIN** where we visit the house of the brilliant composer **Tchaikovsky (entrance included)**. Then we carry on to **SERGIEV POSAD**, where we will see the Monastery of the Trinity, considered Russia's most important spiritual center. **Lunch included.**

In the afternoon, we travel along small roads that pass through historical cities of the Golden Ring; **AL-EXANDROV**, with its Kremlin dedicated to Ivan the Terrible. **YURIEV POLSKIY**, a small provincial city with its historical Kremlin. Our route continues to **SUZDAL**. During **dinner (included)** enjoy a folkloric group who will accompany us with the sound of bala-laikas (not included if there are fewer than 15 participants in the group).

**06 FRI. Suzdal- Vladimir- Moscow.-**

**TODAY'S HIGHLIGHT:** Sightseeing of Suzdal. Lunch included.

In the morning we will see how the famous **Matry-oshka dolls** are made and painted, and you will get an opportunity to learn how to paint them. Then we **visit SUZDAL**, which for many is the most beautiful of the cities of the Golden Ring, with its canals, flowers, domes on the horizon, which give the city a fairytale-like appearance. We will visit the **wooden Architecture Museum**, which illustrates the former peasant life with houses built of trunks, mills and the
