Through vignards landscapes we go on to CHI-LLON CASTLE, built in the waters of the lake. Entrance included to this fantastic mediaeval castle. After this, we will continue to the picturesque walled village of GRUYERES, known worldwide for its cheese. Nearby this area there are several of the main chocolate Swiss factories located (NESTLE amongst them), and we visit the Cailler chocolate factory, with a tasting included!

We continue along small roads between bucolic landscapes of mountains and typical wooden villages. Arrival in the evening to **LEYSIN**, a beautiful holiday town. **Dinner included.**




