

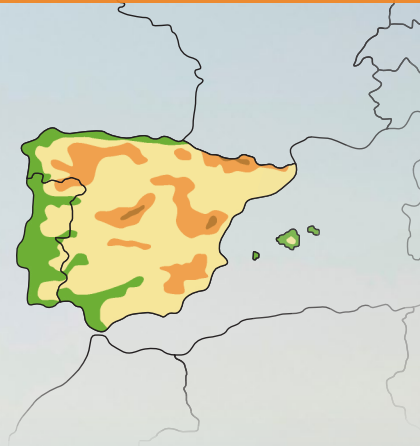

An ancient fortified city, renowned for its mud architecture and traditional kasbahs, it has been the setting for many film productions.





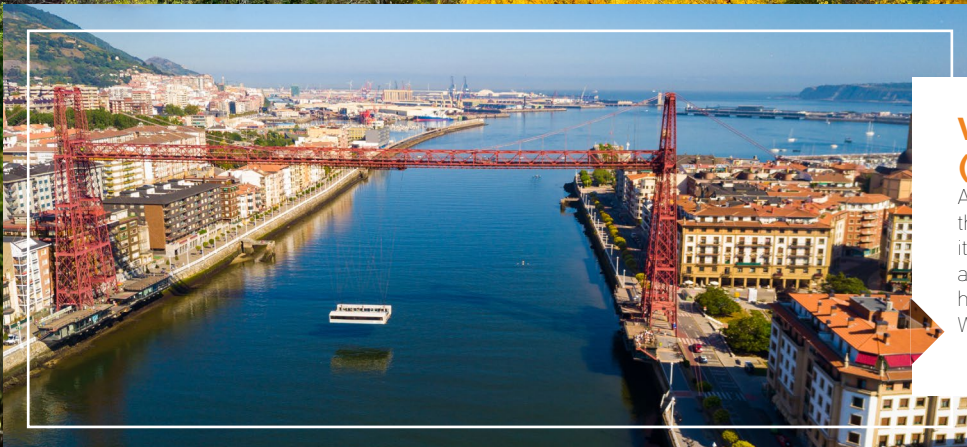

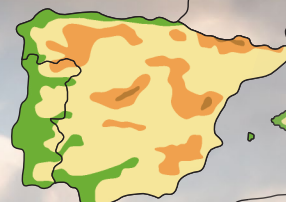


Monte Igueldo Funicular (San Sebastian)
