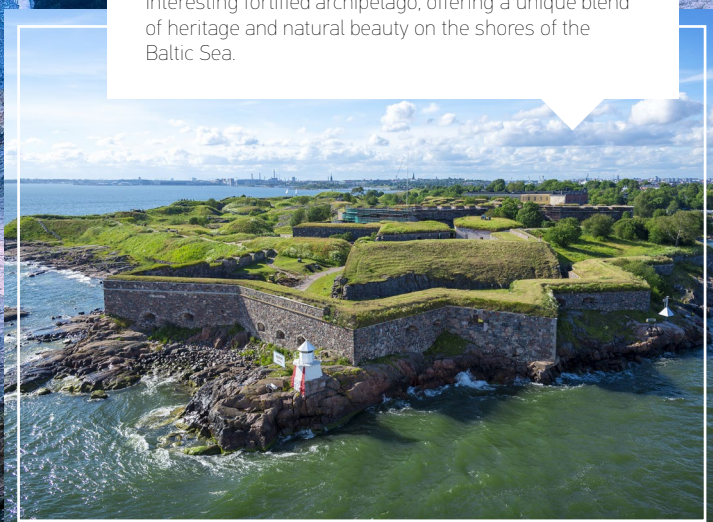
Rundale Palace (Riga)
