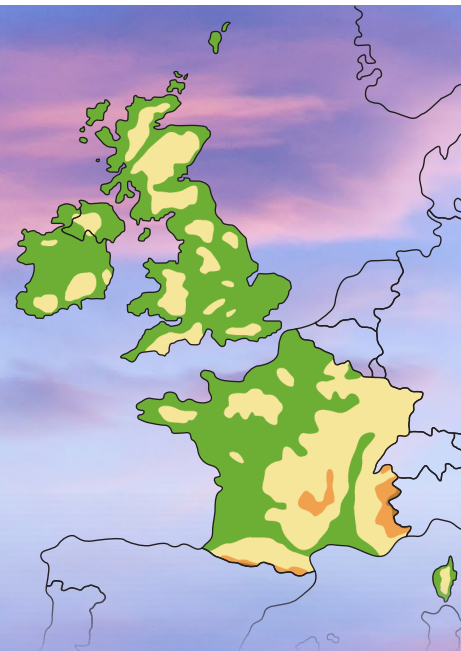

Historic monastery in Ireland, famous for its ruins of an ancient Christian monastery dating back to the Middle Ages and its importance as a center of learning and religion in that period.



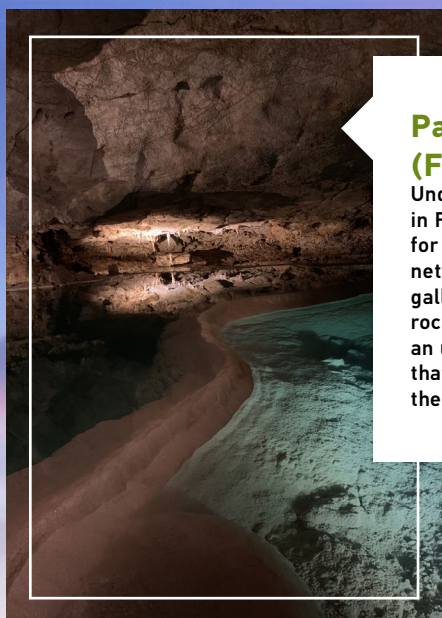
Pitlochry Whiskey Distillery (Scotland)

(Opt. 1) Paris and European Capitals

01 SAT. Paris.-

Welcome! Transfer to hotel and free time.

02 SUN. Paris.-

We get acquainted with the history of France by visiting the Palace of Versailles (admission not included). Later we return to Paris and take the cable car up to the bohemian district of Montmartre. City tour with a local guide.

03 MON. Paris - Rouen.-

Today we will enjoy the incredible views of the city, going up to the second floor of the emblematic Eiffel Tower and taking a cruise along the Seine River. Around 16:00 hrs. we will leave for Rouen, capital of Normandy. Time in the center before going to the hotel.

04 TUE. Rouen - Canterbury - London.-

After a time for a walk around Rouen we travel to the North of France to take a ferry and cross the English Channel to the United Kingdom. We will make a stop in Canterbury, religious capital of England. Once in London we will stop at one of the symbols of the city, the Tower Bridge before going to the hotel.

05 WED. London.-

City tour of London with a stop at Buckingham Palace to see, on the days that it's celebrated, the "Changing of the Guard" ceremony. Free time in the afternoon. In the late evening we will stroll through the lively areas of Leicester and Soho.

06 THU. London - Colchester - Ferry.-

In the morning we will go to the British Museum, one of the best museums in the world. Transfer to the popular district of Camden Town. We leave London for Colchester, the oldest city in England. In Colchester we take a ferry that heads to Holland. Night on board.

07 FRI. Ferry- Volendam - Amsterdam.-

Arrival in Holland early in the morning. We will make a stop in the picturesque fishing village of Volendam. In Amsterdam we will include a sight-seeing tour of the city of canals and an evening transfer to Rembrandtplein.

08 SAT. Amsterdam - Hamelin - Berlin.-

Continuing our journey, we enter Germany. We visit Hamelin, the town of the Brothers Grimm's "Pied Piper". We continue through Marienborn, the former border between East and West Germany. Arrival in Berlin in the evening.

09 SUN. Berlin.-

City tour of Berlin, including the Holocaust Memorial and the Berlin Wall Memorial Museum. In the evening a transfer to the lively Kantstrasse area.

After breakfast, end of our services.

Today we will have a cruise over the Rhine in its most picturesque sector, between Rudesheim and St. Goar. After that, in Cologne, we can admire its Gothic cathedral. We continue to Holland. Amsterdam, arrival in the evening.

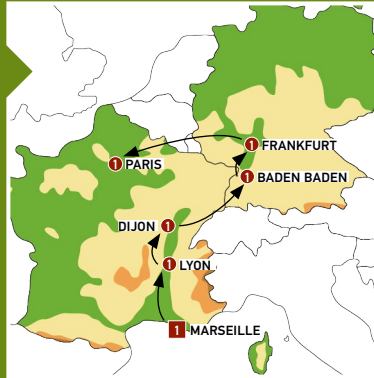

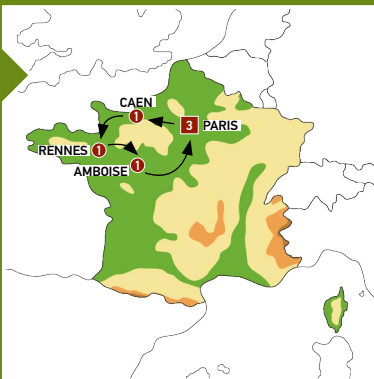

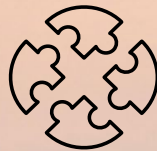
