### Alhambra of Granada

Our circuits include tickets to this palace and fortress, an emblem of one of the most fascinating periods in the political and social history of the Hispano-Muslim era.



### Nerja

We'll visit the Nerja Caves (admission included), spectacular caverns thousands of years old that preserve both prehistoric paintings and stunning stalactites and stalagmites of great geological value.



### Cambados (Galicia)

We'll embark on a boat tour through the stunning Rías Baixas, offering a truly unique experience. Discover the fascinating process of mussel and oyster cultivation, followed by a delightful tasting paired with a glass of exquisite local wine.



### Itálica (Seville)

Itálica, the first Roman city established in the Iberian Peninsula, is renowned as the birthplace of emperors Trajan and Hadrian. This archaeological site preserves impressive remains, including the amphitheater, mosaics, and streets, offering a glimpse into the splendor of the Roman Empire in Hispania.



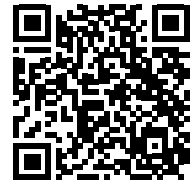
### Andalusian Center of Flamenco (Jerez de la Frontera, Cádiz)

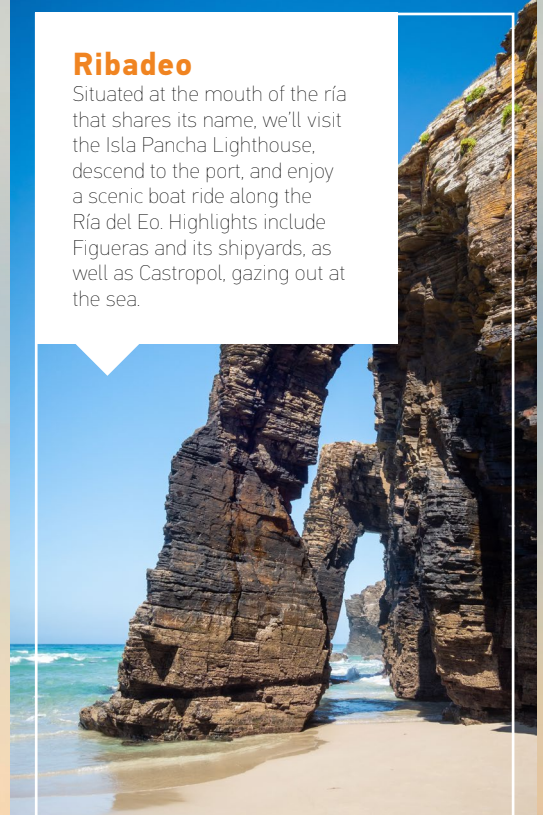
## Muelle de las Carabelas (Palos de la frontera, Huelva)

These are replicas of the Niña, the Pinta, and the Santa María, the ships used by Columbus on his 1492 voyage to America. They are located at the Muelle de las Carabelas in Huelva, a key site in the history of the discovery of the New World.



## Ribadeo

Situated at the mouth of the ría that shares its name, we'll visit the Isla Pancha Lighthouse, descend to the port, and enjoy a scenic boat ride along the Ría del Eo. Highlights include Figueras and its shipyards, as well as Castropol, gazing out at the sea.



## Frigiliana (Málaga)

We'll visit one of the most beautiful villages in Andalusia, with its steep, narrow streets lined with whitewashed houses. Every corner reveals a new charm in this enchanting destination.



## Alhama de Granada

Nestled in a natural setting surrounded by olive groves and mountains, you'll have the opportunity to relax in its therapeutic hot springs (admission included) or indulge in optional treatments such as massages or natural wraps.
