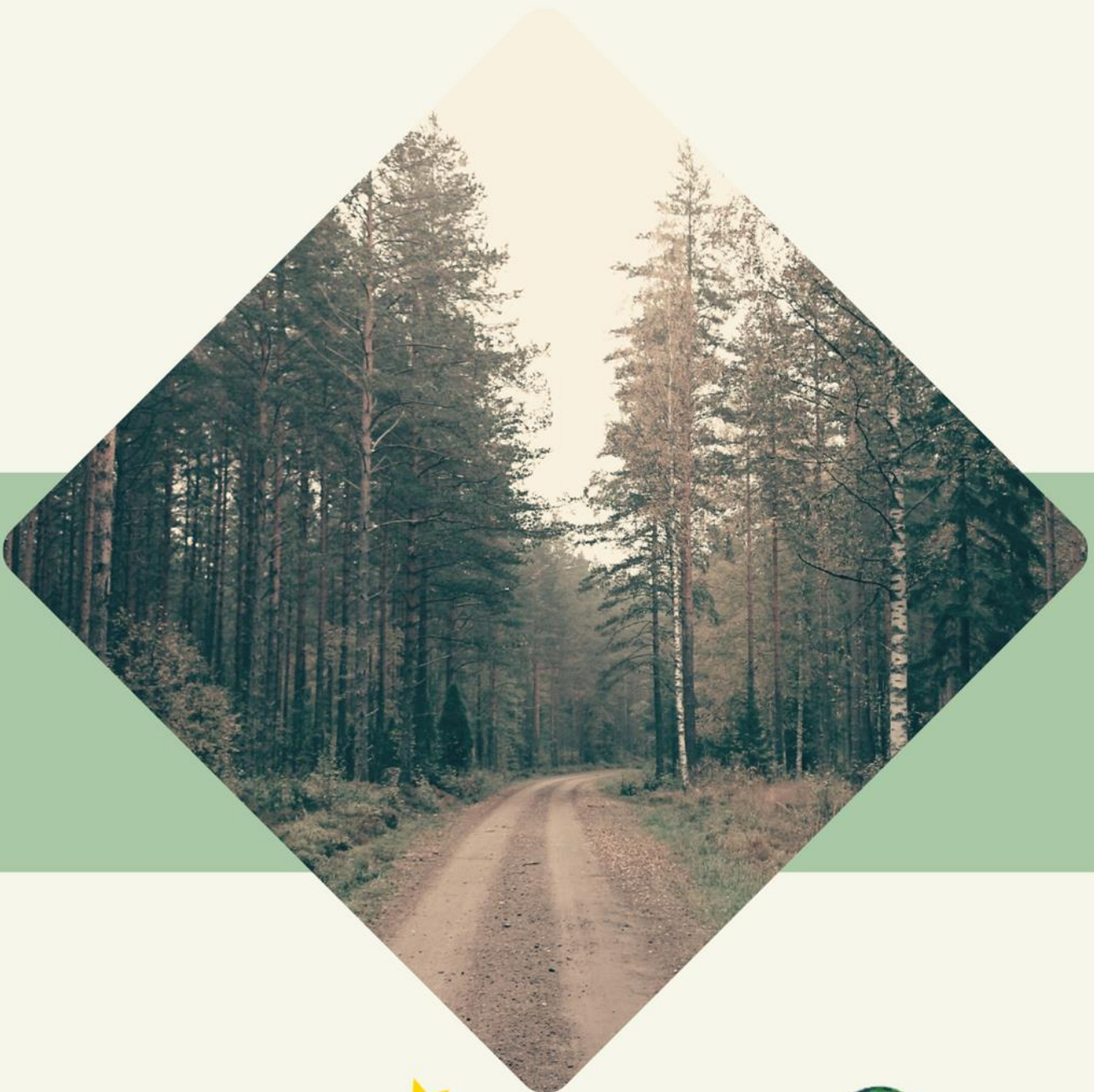

EUROPAMUNDO'S CLIMATE ACTION PLAN.

GLASGOW DECLARATION.

At Europa Mundo Vacaciones (Europamundo) we signed the Glasgow Declaration in 2021 with a firm commitment to transform tourism and achieve the effective reduction of CO2 emissions by 2030 and reach net zero emissions by 2050.

We want to make our commitment public, based on the following pillars:

- **Measurement:** since 2014 at Europamundo we have been calculating our impact on the atmosphere by calculating the CO2 footprint of our activity according to the GHG protocol. We are committed to keep on measuring our carbon footprint year after year.

- **Decarbonisation:** likewise since 2014 we have been taking measures to decarbonise and mitigate climate change: energy audits every 4 years, green energy contracting, Euro VI buses in our circuits, waste management in the office, bike parking in the facilities, climate change awareness and carbon neutrality through offsetting. Here we commit to continue with energy audits, waste management, green energy contracting, at least 2 workshops and/or talks per year to raise awareness of the importance of climate change and decarbonisation, and to maintain carbon neutrality.

- **Regeneration:** in 2022, through Treedom, we have planted the Europamundo forest, with 244 trees around the world (Africa and Latin America), contributing to the restoration and protection of biodiversity, local populations and the absorption of CO2 from the atmosphere. We are committed to continue planting 100 trees annually to restore and protect ecosystems.

- **Collaboration and funding:** partnerships are essential to succeed in combating climate change. That is why we weave a network of alliances with our partners and collaborators to strengthen governance and capacity for action. Through our foundation, Europamundo Foundation, we also collaborate with other organisations and NGOs on climate action, decarbonisation, environmental protection and sustainable tourism. We are committed to fund at least one project per year related to climate action and/or sustainable tourism.

ACTION PLAN TIMELINE: 2023 - 2030.

1. Measurement and decarbonisation.

Over the next 7 years Europamundo will continue to measure its carbon footprint and commits to halving its CO2 emissions in paper consumption to zero by 2030. In 2019 it was 363 tonnes and by 2023 it will be halved, and zero or close to zero by 2030.

In addition, all CO2e emissions generated by Europamundo in the coming years will be offset by being CO2 neutral from 2014.

2. Regeneration.

In 2022 we committed to plant a forest of trees through the company Treedom, our idea is to plant 200 trees every year.

3. Collaboration and financing.

Through SDG 17 Partnerships to Achieve the Goals we have a priority relationship with our stakeholders and we aim to fund 2 environmental projects per year through our Foundation and hold awareness raising workshops with some of our key stakeholders, one per year on 5 June, World Environment Day.
